Oliverian Brook Trail

New Hampshire

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The Oliverian Brook Trail follows the course of Oliverian Brook through the dense forest of White Mountain National Forest. The trail, open to cross-country skiing in winter, heads toward Passaconaway Cutoff, 1.9 miles, near the base of Mt. Passaconaway. You can also go to Pausus Pass, 4.4 miles.

Approximately one mile of this trail follows the corridor of the former Swift River Railroad company, which shuttered their logging operations in 1916.

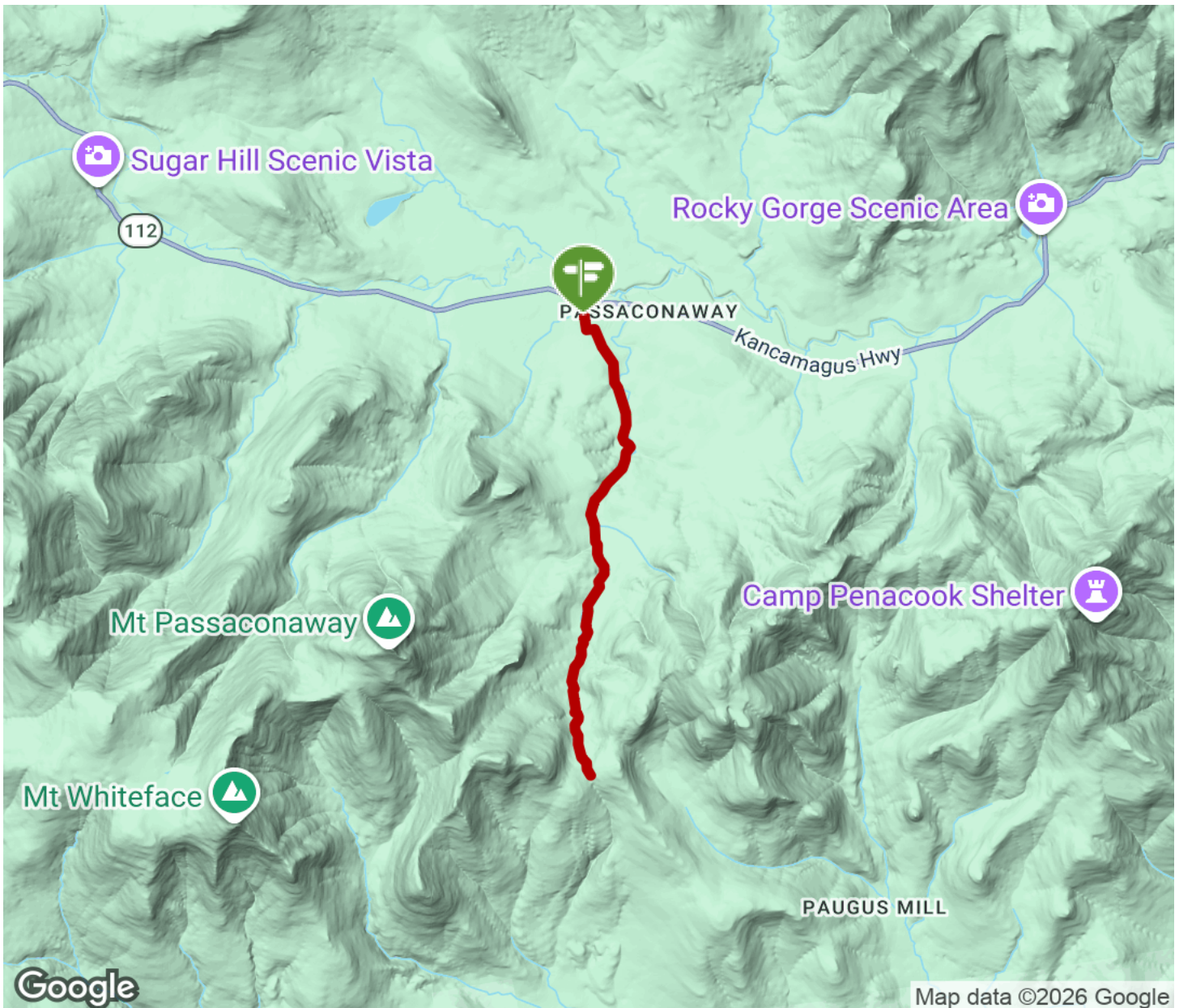
Parking & Trail Access
