The Branford Trolley Trail is essentially a long footbridge occupying an old bridge along the route of an abandoned trolley



The Branford Trolley Trail is essentially a long footbridge occupying an old bridge along the route of an abandoned trolley track. The bridge links nature trails on both sides of the water through a marsh habitat that is home to many shorebirds, fish, mammals and invertebrates.

The trail is part of the growing <u>Shoreline Greenway Trail</u> that will one day stretch 25 miles through four towns along Connecticut's southern coast.


Parking & Trail Access
