About the Route

The long bridge links nature trails on both sides of the water through a marsh habitat that is home to many shorebirds, fish, mammals and invertebrates.

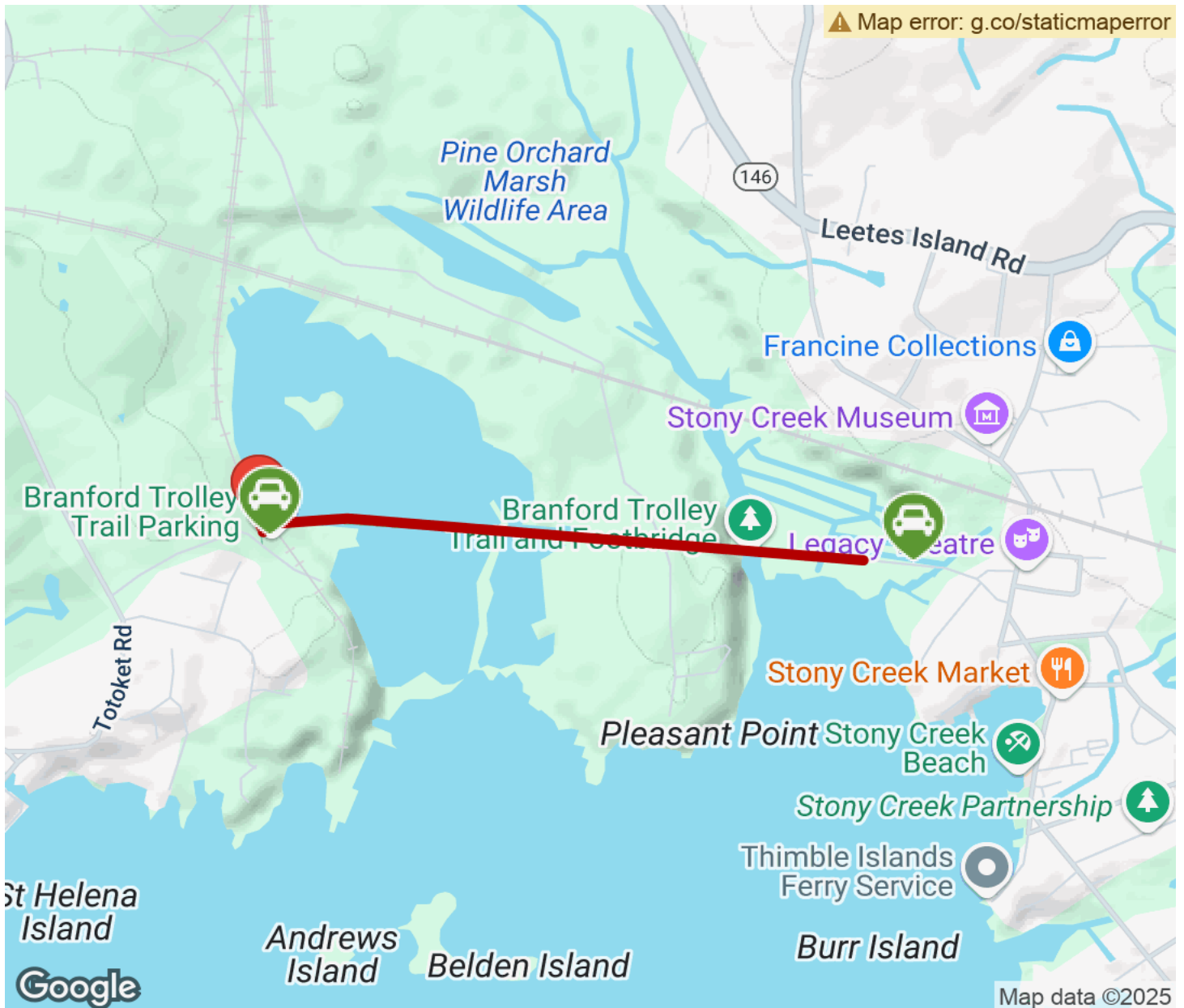
The Branford Trolley Trail runs between Tilcon Rd (Pine Orchard) and Thimble Island Rd (Stony Creek), both of which offer parking.
