The General James A. Van Fleet State Trail runs for 29 miles between Mabel and Polk City through some of Florida's most scenic



The General James A. Van Fleet State Trail runs for 29 miles between Mabel and Polk City through some of Florida's most scenic rural landscapes. At least one-third of the trail passes through Florida's 322,690-acre Green Swamp with many opportunities to spot wetland wildlife.

About the Route

The northern endpoint of the General James A. Van State Trail is located in Mabel, just off State Route 50. The first 10 miles heading south on the trail run alongside the Richloam Wildlife Management Area, offering a serene and beautiful trip through the area. The Bay Lake Trailhead marks the north entrance into the Green Swamp Wilderness Preserve. From here on watch for feral pigs, armadillos, buzzards, tortoises and possibly an

alligator or two basking on the trail's warm asphalt surface.

The trail passes through about 9 miles of the Green Swamp Wilderness Preserve with The Green Pond Rail trailhead marking the southern boundary for the preserve. From here the trail continues for another 10 miles until it reaches its southern endpoint in Polk City. The arrow-straight route, with one slight curve, has made it a favorite among time-trial bicyclists, thanks to its remote setting, so be aware an occasional speedster might pass by on the trail. The southern Polk City endpoint offers picnic areas and restroom facilities, plus an expansive field of clipped grass, perfect for a game of pickup soccer.

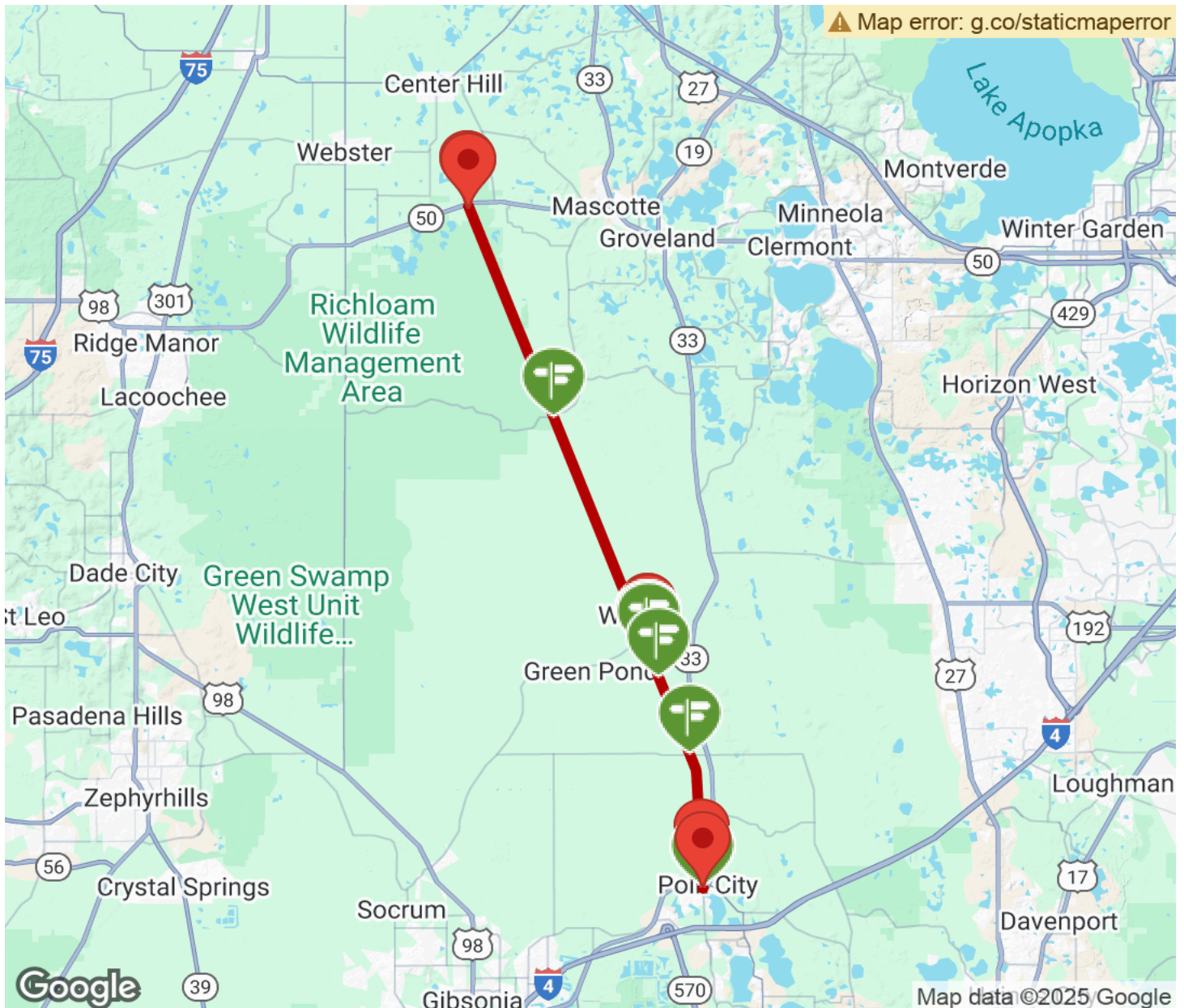
