The South Riverside Trail is one in a series of trail systems throughout Cedar Falls, Iowa. Starting at the northern endpoint in



The South Riverside Trail is one in a series of trail systems throughout Cedar Falls, Iowa. Starting at the northern endpoint in Cedar Falls, the first section of the trail runs from Main street at the way through Cedar Falls until the Hartman Reserve Nature Center south of the city. Along this section of the trail, the South Riverside Trail passes by notable attractions like Washington Park, Hartman Reserve Nature Center and Pfeiffer Springs Park. A spur on the west end takes you across the river on a pedestrian bridge. From there, the South Riverside Trail meets up with the [Cedar Valley Lakes Trail](#).

The northern endpoint of the southern section of the trail begins along Forrester Ave. and passes along the Hippodrome Theater and along the Cedar River until ending in downtown Waterloo

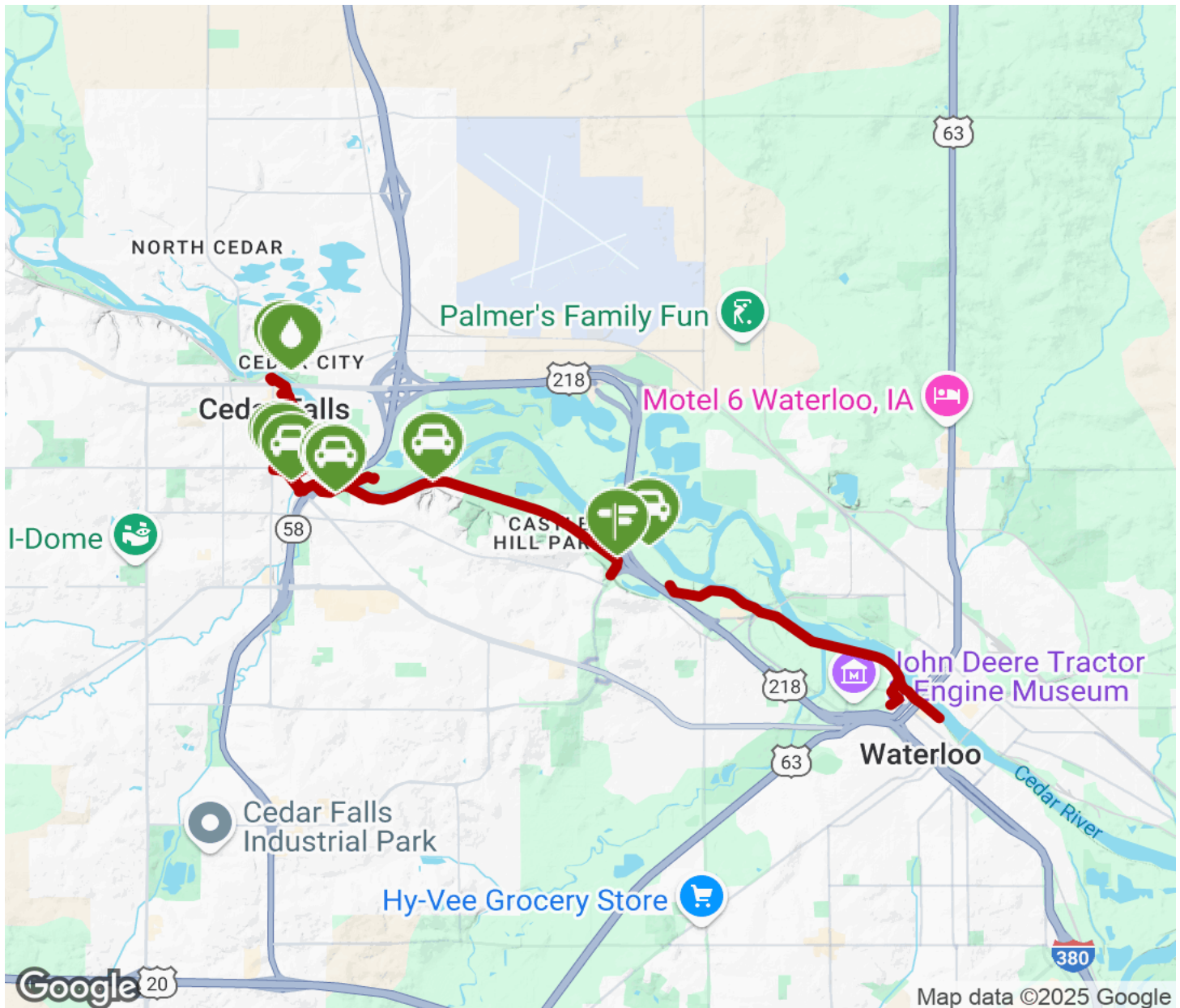
