## Pend d'Oreille Bay Trail

*The Pend d'Oreille Bay Trail offers a wooded, unpaved route along its namesake bay between Ponderay and Sandpoint in northern*



The Pend d'Oreille Bay Trail offers a wooded, unpaved route along its namesake bay between Ponderay and Sandpoint in northern Idaho. In addition to the waterfront views, you can see the Cabinet Mountains from the trail.

If you'd like to enjoy a picnic lunch before or after your ride, Sandpoint City Beach Park is located just a half mile south of the trail's southern end. The 22-acre park offers picnic tables, restrooms, a sandy beach, and other recreational amenities. For more riding, head west from the park along Bridge Street and, after passing under Sandpoint Bypass, look to your right and you'll see the entrance for [Sandpoint Byway Trail](#), a 2.5-mile paved pathway heading north.

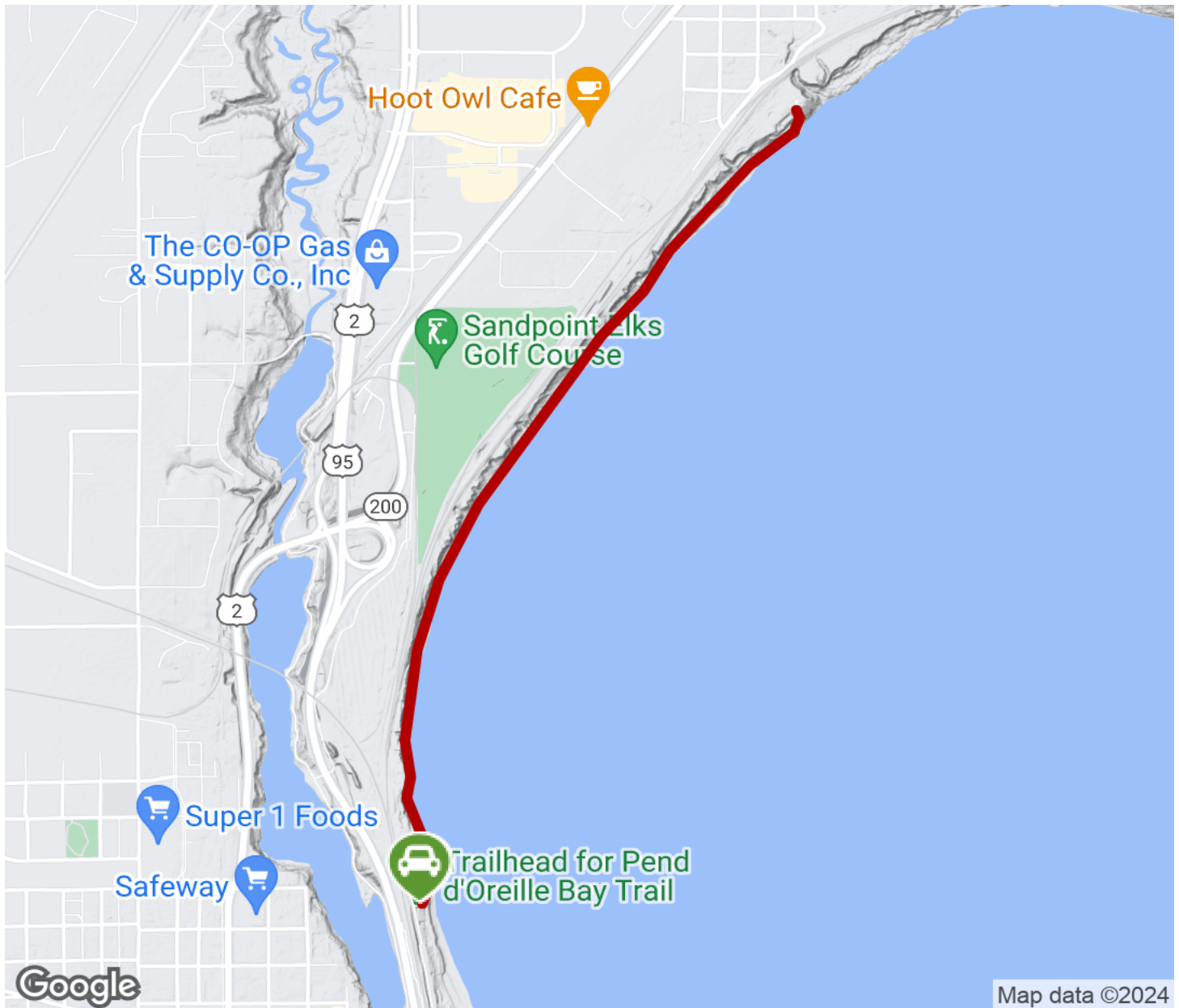
## Parking & Trail Access
