The Joe Stengel Trail follows an old railroad corridor for 7 miles between the town of Polo and the much smaller community of



The Joe Stengel Trail follows an old railroad corridor for 7 miles between the town of Polo and the much smaller community of Woosung. The trail corridor traces farm country along a route scattered with trees. The natural surface can be rough going in places. In Polo the trail follows city streets, ending at a small cemetery north of town.

Another shorter piece of the trail is found farther south by Dixon. The segment is connected to the <u>Lowell Parkway Trail</u> at Lowell Park and passes through Penrose Prairie. There are plans to link the two segments one day.
