The trail offers a pleasant stroll or relaxing bike ride, with access to town amenities.

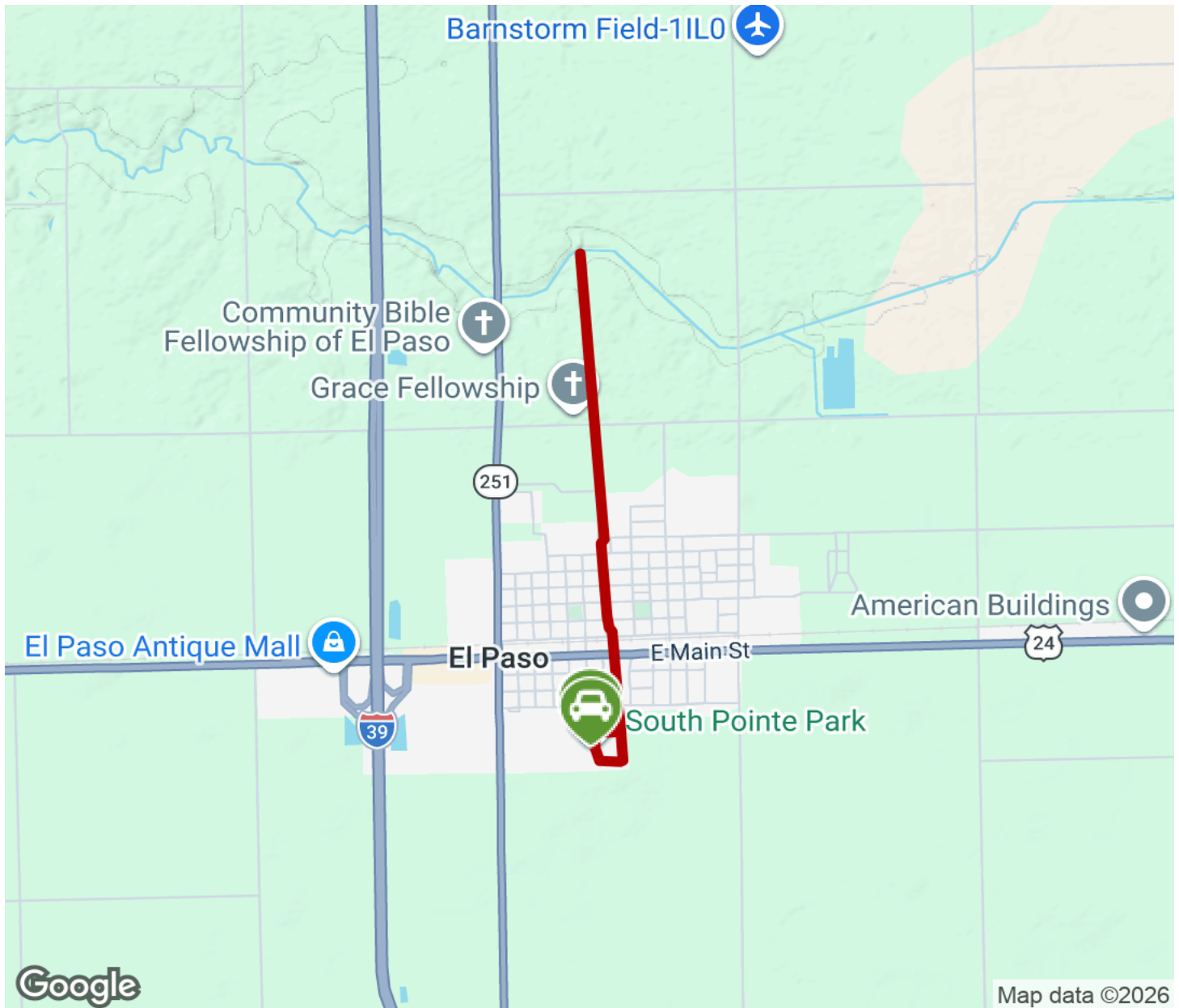
## Parking & Trail Access
