The Lincoln Prairie Grass Trail for 13.4 miles, much of the way along an old railroad right-of-way between County Highway 2 east



The Lincoln Prairie Grass Trail for 13.4 miles, much of the way along an old railroad right-of-way between County Highway 2 east of Charleston and N 16th Street in Mattoon; an additional 1-mile loop takes you around the ball fields to Logan Street.

All 12 miles of the trail's surface is paved. The trail is open year-round from dawn to dusk.

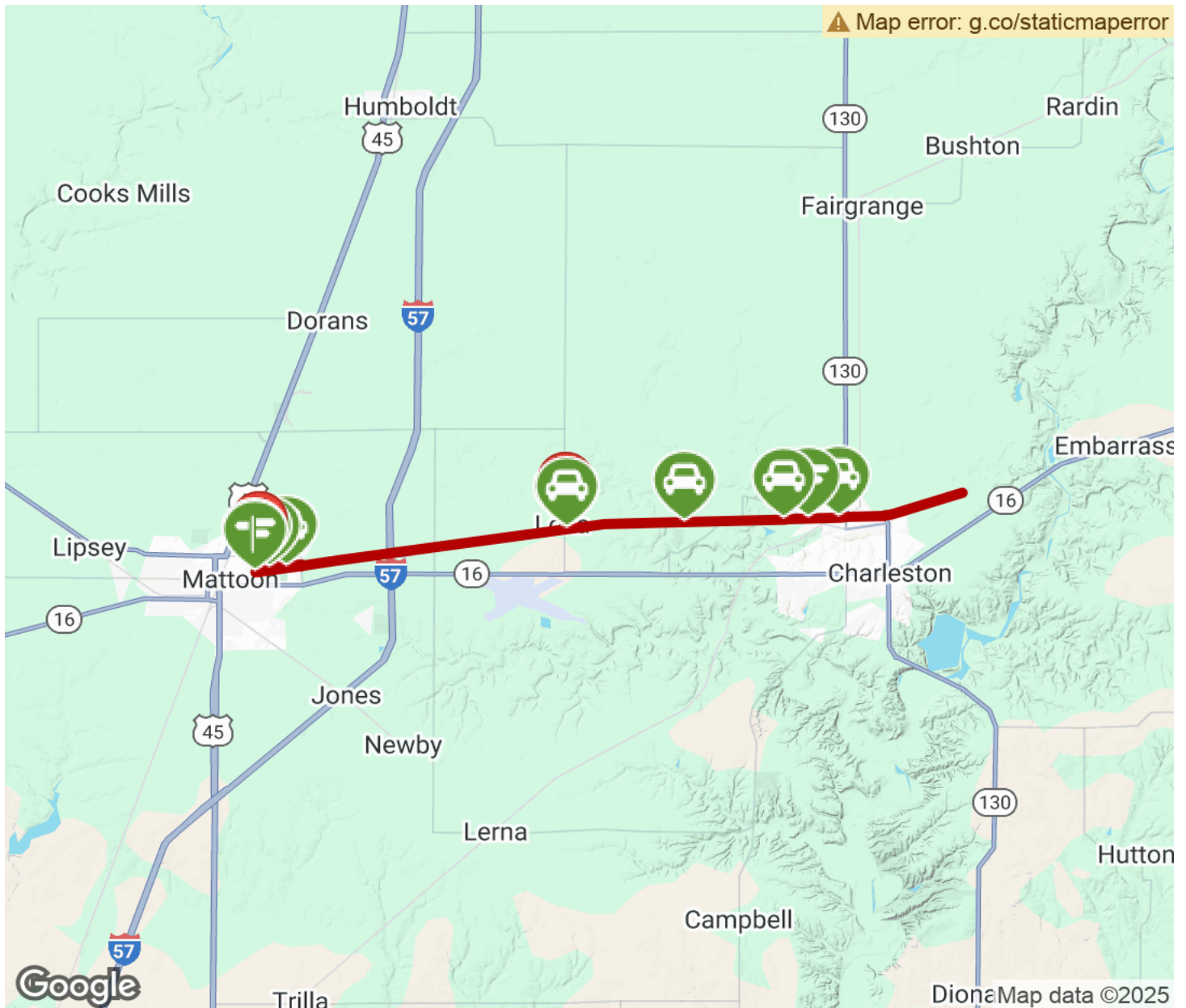
Parking & Trail Access

Parking is available at the trail's end in Mattoon. Parking is also available midway off Loxa Road where the trail crosses the road. In Charleston, there is a small parking area between the industrial sites where Madison Avenue and CR 7/Old State Road run parallel. Additional parking is at the ball fields on Division Street.
