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About the Route

The trail is one of dozens in the Chicagoland area, all of which link to one another for cross-city access to suburbs, parks, business districts and scenic Lake Michigan. At its eastern end, the North Shore Bike Path connects to the [Robert McClory Bike Path](#) at Sheridan Road and Scranton Avenue.

Just east of Libertyville, the North Shore Bike Path links to the north-south running [Des Plaines River Trail](#) (east of the river).

The North Shore Bike Path runs between Robert McClory Bike Path (Lake Bluff) and Brice Ave. (Mundelein).

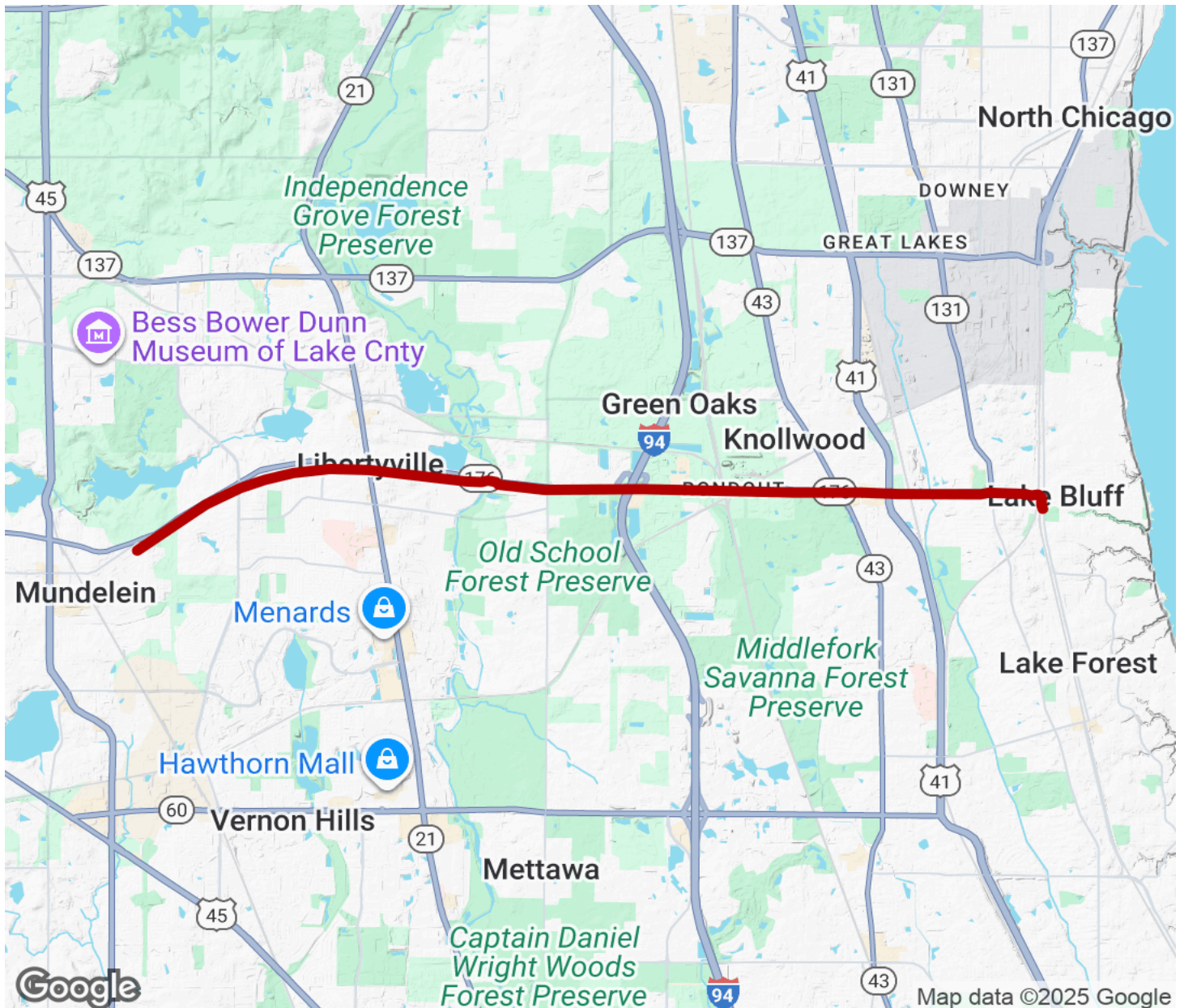
There's no official parking for the trail but parking is available in Libertyville and Mundelein.
