O'Malley's Alley is a paved, half-mile trail through a residential area south of Kaufman Lake on the western end of Champaign. On



O'Malley's Alley is a paved, half-mile trail through a residential area south of Kaufman Lake on the western end of Champaign. On Kenwood Road (at the eastern end of the trail), trail users can head south on the sidewalk along the roadway to reach Centennial High School, Jefferson Middle School and Centennial Park. At the south end of the park, there is the unique attraction of Prairie Farm run by the city's park district and home to horses, cows, sheep and other barnyard animals.

For a longer journey, pick up the paved spur that connects to the trail just east of the bridge. Follow it along the east side of Copper Slough, then cross W. Springfield Avenue and head into Kaufman Park, where there's a gravel road trail users can take all the way around the lake.

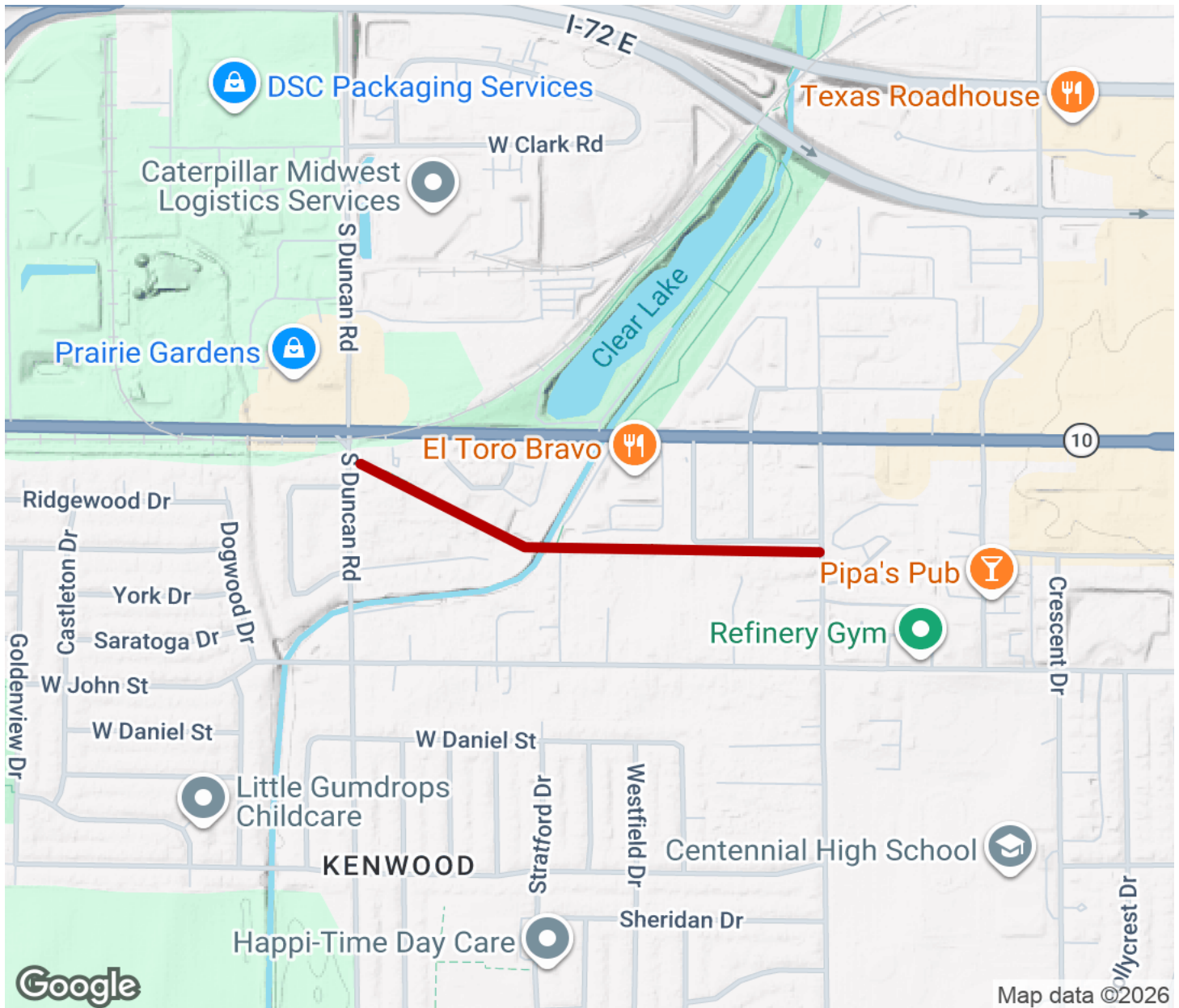
Parking & Trail Access
