

Connections

At the Central Canal Towpath's northern endpoint, continue along the 18-mile Monon Trail.

Where the trail crosses W 30th St., the trail meets the White River Wapahani Trail.

At the southern end of the trail, the towpath meets the <u>Fall</u> Creek Trail.

Overview

The 6.4-mile Central Canal Towpath, also known as the IWC Canal Greenway, features two 19th-century iron bridges that cross the waterway, designated an American Water Landmark. Following the tree-lined, crushed limestone path, trail users should keep their eyes open for blue herons, ducks, geese, and turtles. The trail runs through the northern end of Indianapolis and connects to several other trails.

About the Route

The trail runs past a number of cultural amenities, including Butler University, Holcomb Gardens, and the Indianapolis Museum of Art.
