Little Turtle Waterway Trail

The Little Turtle Waterway Trail covers 1 mile along the Wabash River and is part of a 5-acre park in downtown Logansport. The



The Little Turtle Waterway Trail covers 1 mile along the Wabash River and is part of a 5-acre park in downtown Logansport. The rail-trail part of the equation comes from what is called the Gateway, formerly a railroad signal bridge, which was moved from the west side of town. The Gateway has four granite medallions designed by a Miami, Ohio, artist and depicting the symbolism of the Miami, the people of Chief Little Turtle.

The Plaza area of this charming park and trail has seating ledges overlooking the river. It's also notable for its artwork: 32 granite pavers, designed by local artists, depict scenes from local history. In addition, other works of art rendered in natural elements.


