The Haskell Rail-Trail, billed as the 'first operational rail-trail in Kansas', spans the eastern edge of the campus of Haskell Indian



The Haskell Rail-Trail, billed as the 'first operational rail-trail in Kansas', spans the eastern edge of the campus of Haskell Indian Nations University in Lawrence. In the north, the trail connects to the [Burroughs Creek Trail and Linear Park](#), which heads closer to downtown Lawrence.

Eventually, the trail will become an integral component of the loop around Lawrence: the planned construction of a new portion of the S. Lawrence Trafficway will include an eastward extension of the [S. Lawrence Trafficway Trail](#), which will be just a couple blocks shy of the Haskell Rail-Trail's southern endpoint.

This trail is an integral part of the developing 22-mile Lawrence Loop around the city.

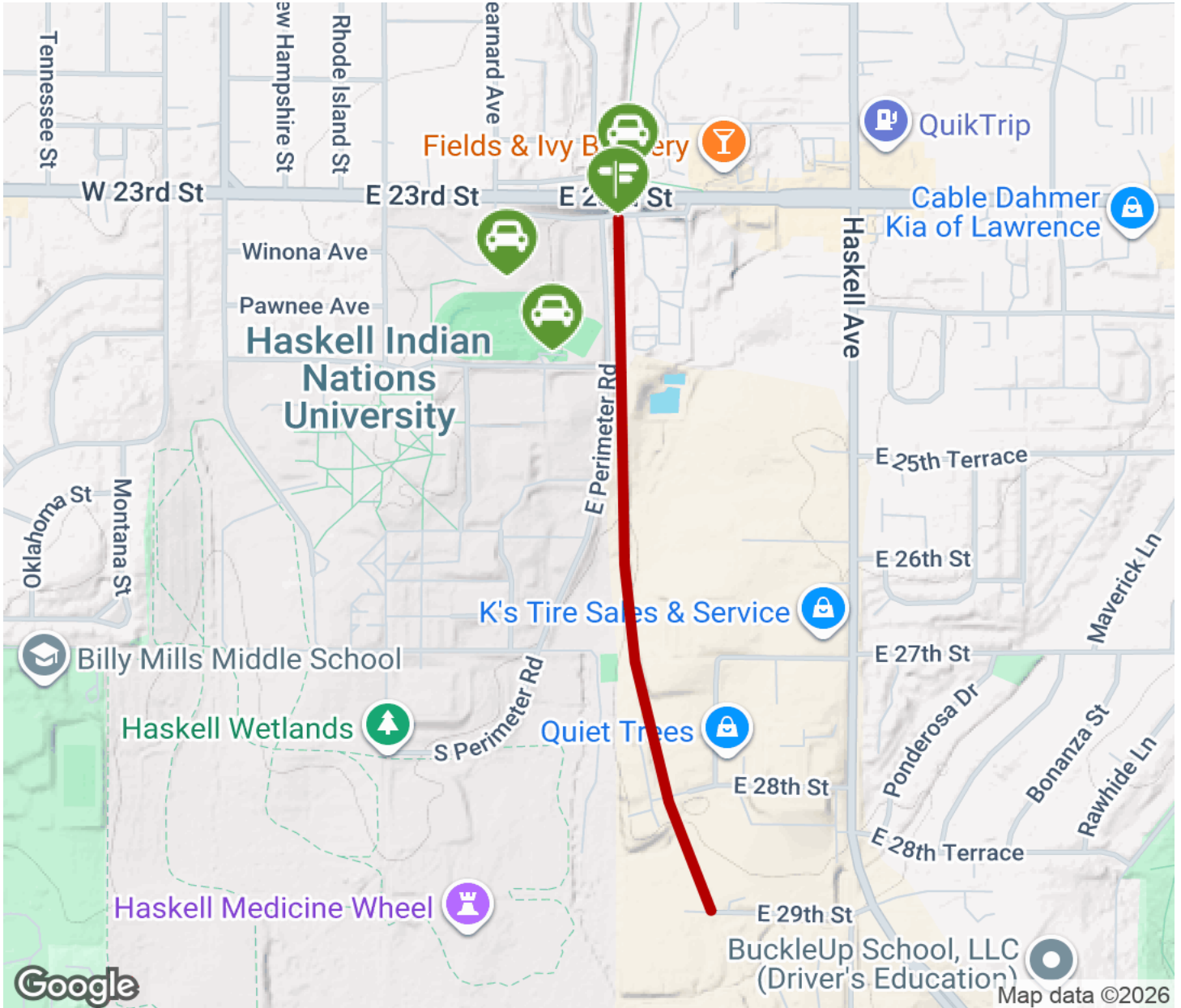
Parking for the Haskell Rail-Trail is available on the campus of Haskell Indian Nations University off N. Perimeter Road.
