The Manhattan Linear Park Trail runs for 9 miles and forms a semi-circle. The trail surface varies from crushed limestone to concrete sidewalks and crosses only a few roads.

Part of the trail skirts atop a Kansas River levee, winding around the southern edge of the city through a largely rural landscape. Where the trail heads north again toward the city, it links shopping districts with suburbs. Trail amenities include signage, benches and distance markers.

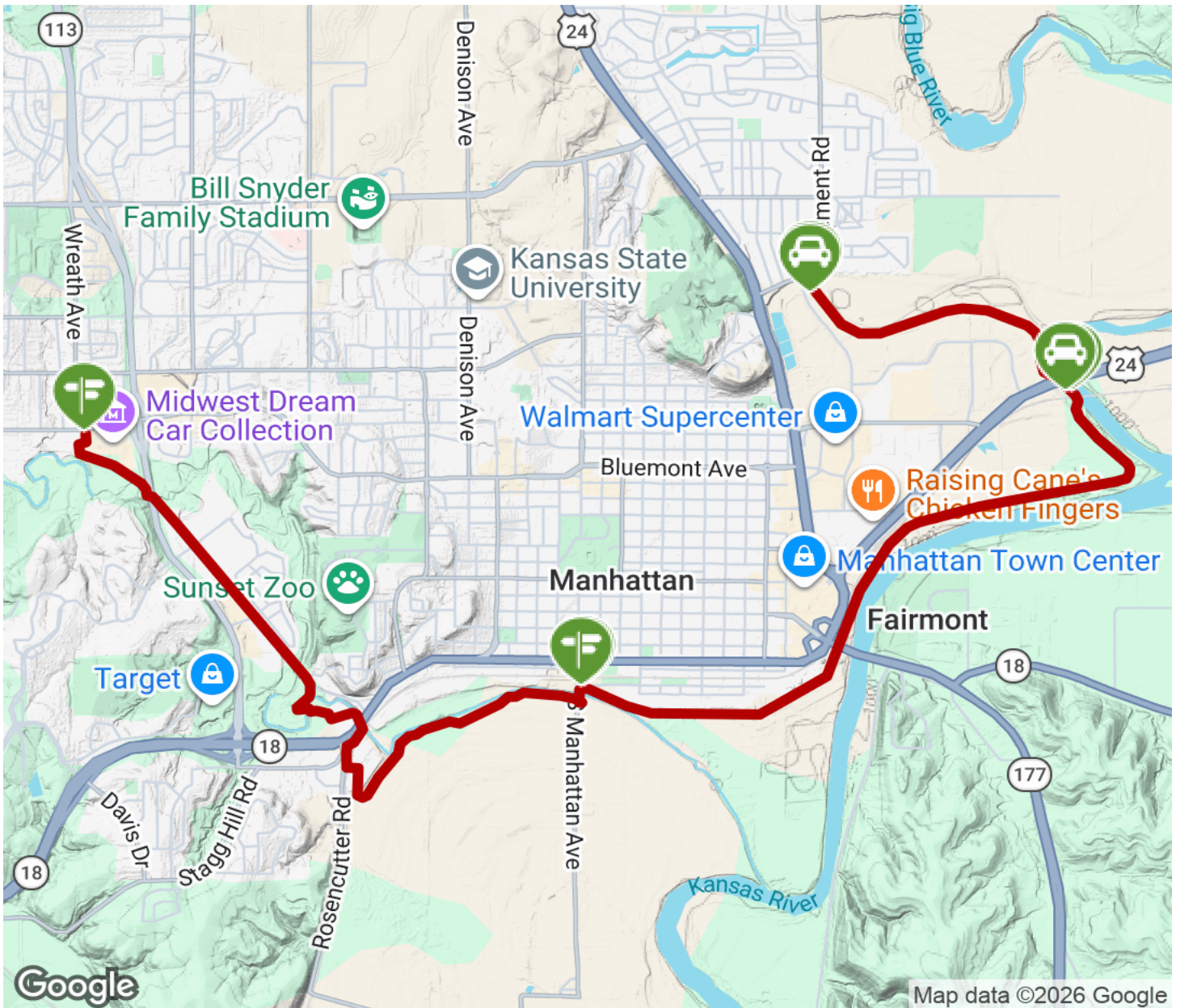
