*The Felch Grade Trail is a rough-surfaced route between the communities of Narenta and Felch in Michigan's Upper Peninsula.*



The Felch Grade Trail is a rough-surfaced route between the communities of Narenta and Felch in Michigan's Upper Peninsula. For most of its length, the trail parallels State Route 69, but awareness of the lightly-traveled road is masked by the vegetation that has grown since the corridor was abandoned in 1970. And, most likely, trail users will be surprised by the amazing number of white-tailed deer using the trail as a travel route.

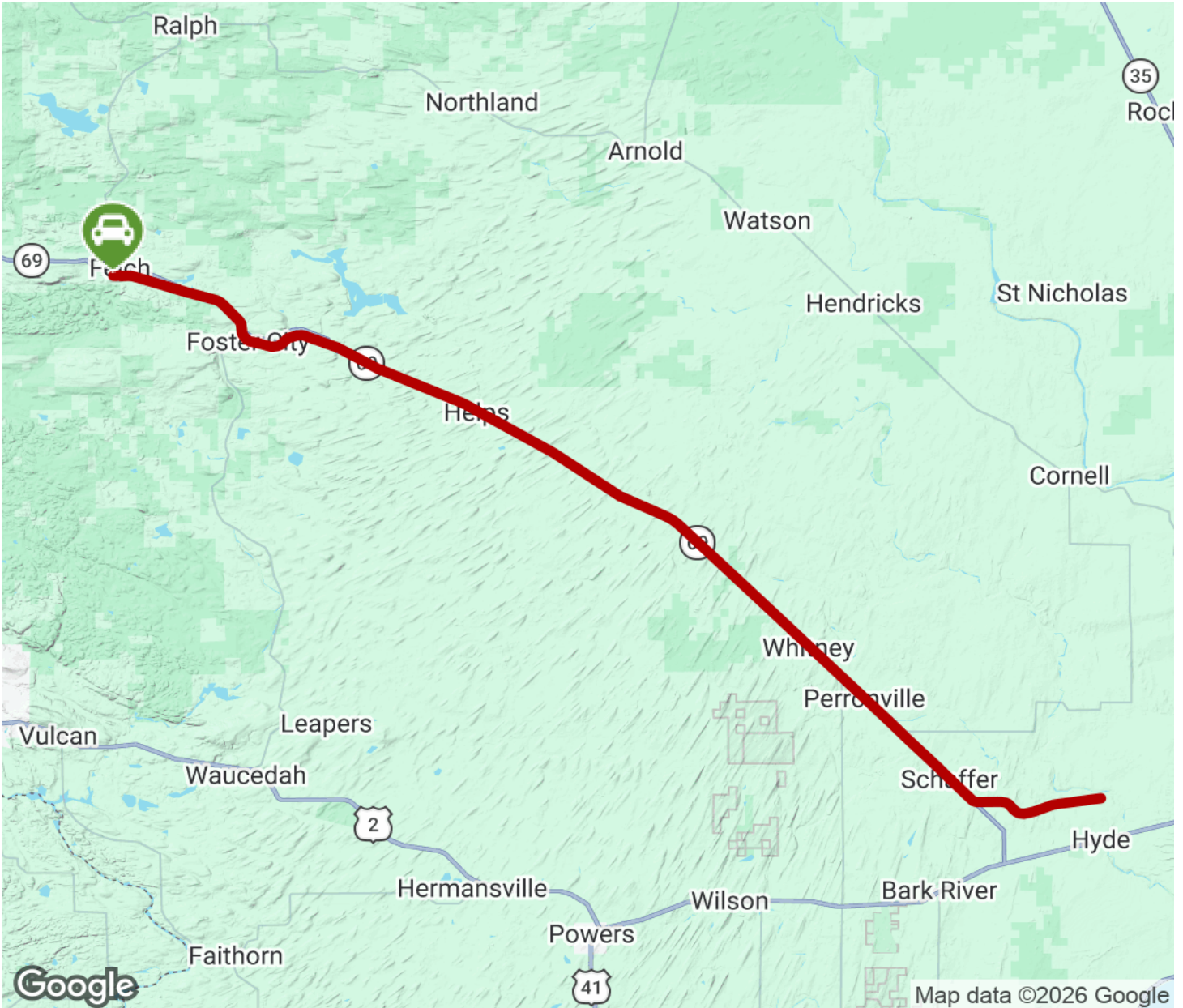
