The Freda Grade Trail—also known as Trail 121 on Michigan snowmobile maps—connects with the Bill Nicholls Trail just north



The Freda Grade Trail—also known as Trail 121 on Michigan snowmobile maps—connects with the [Bill Nicholls Trail](#) just north of South Range and offers riders a fun-filled trek to view Lake Superior to the north. The trail has a dirt surface, making bikes with thicker tires a necessity.

Just to the east of the trail's northern trailhead in Redridge, the Redridge Steel Dam stands tall over the Salmon Trout River. The impressive structure is one of only a handful of dams ever constructed in the United States of steel.
