Iron Range Trails - Crystal Falls to Iron River Trail

Michigan



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The Crystal Falls to Iron River section of the Iron Range Trail system is primarily used by snowmobiles and ATVs. The trail follows an old railroad corridor through the bogs, lakes and forests of Michigan's Upper Peninsula, between the towns of Iron River and Crystal Falls. The trail meets the [State Line Trail](#) just west of Stambaugh Airport in Iron River. The east end of the trail connects to the [Crystal Falls to Stager](#) segment.

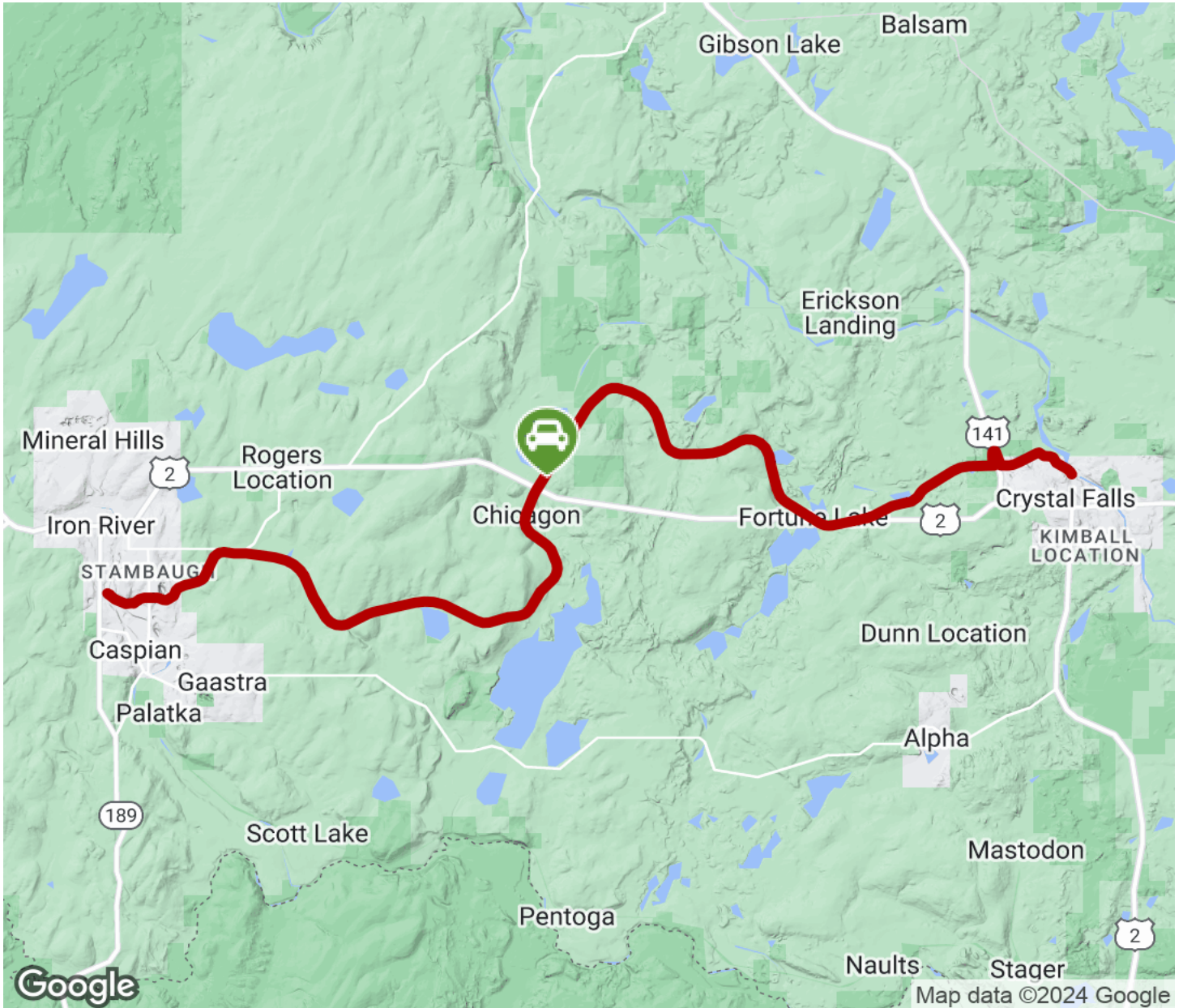
Parking & Trail Access
