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The Lakeside Trail system offers more than 25 miles of paved paths through the villages of Fruitport, Ferrysburg, and Spring Lake. Its main loop circles Spring Lake (the lake) and encompasses spur trails through the towns of Spring Lake and Ferrysburg. The trail links scenic parks with waterfront vistas, charming neighborhoods and village amenities. You can also connect to the [North Bank Trail](#), [Grand Haven Waterfront Trail](#), and [Linear Trail Park](#).

In Ferrysburg, there are widened shoulders on North Shore Road, which you can use to reach North Beach Park and North Pier Park along the Lake Michigan.

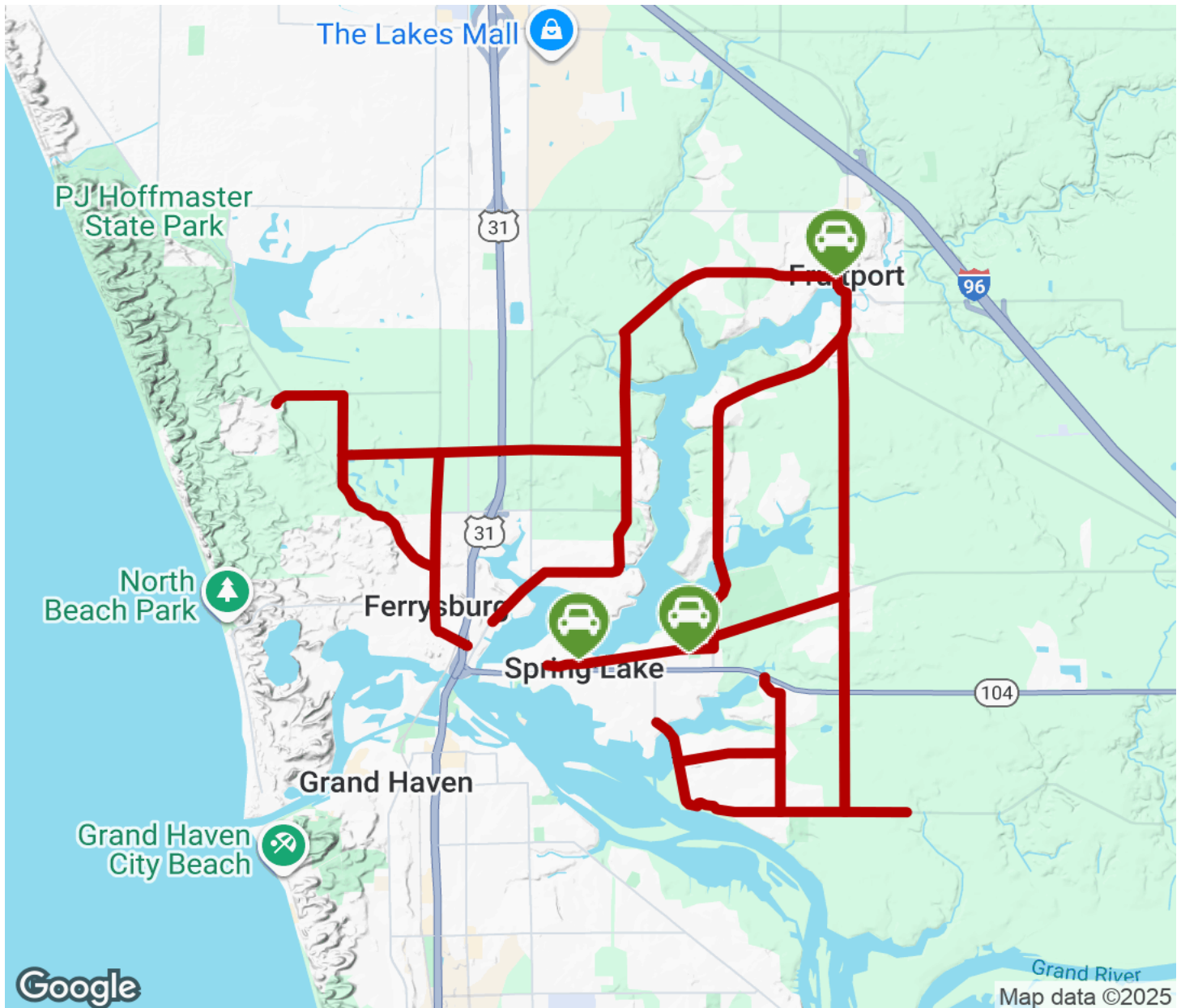
Parking & Trail Access
