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The Main Trail runs for just 0.5 mile along an east-west corridor through the Whitehouse Nature Center. The trail links a series of loop trails through the nature center and begins at the visitor center off Farley Road. 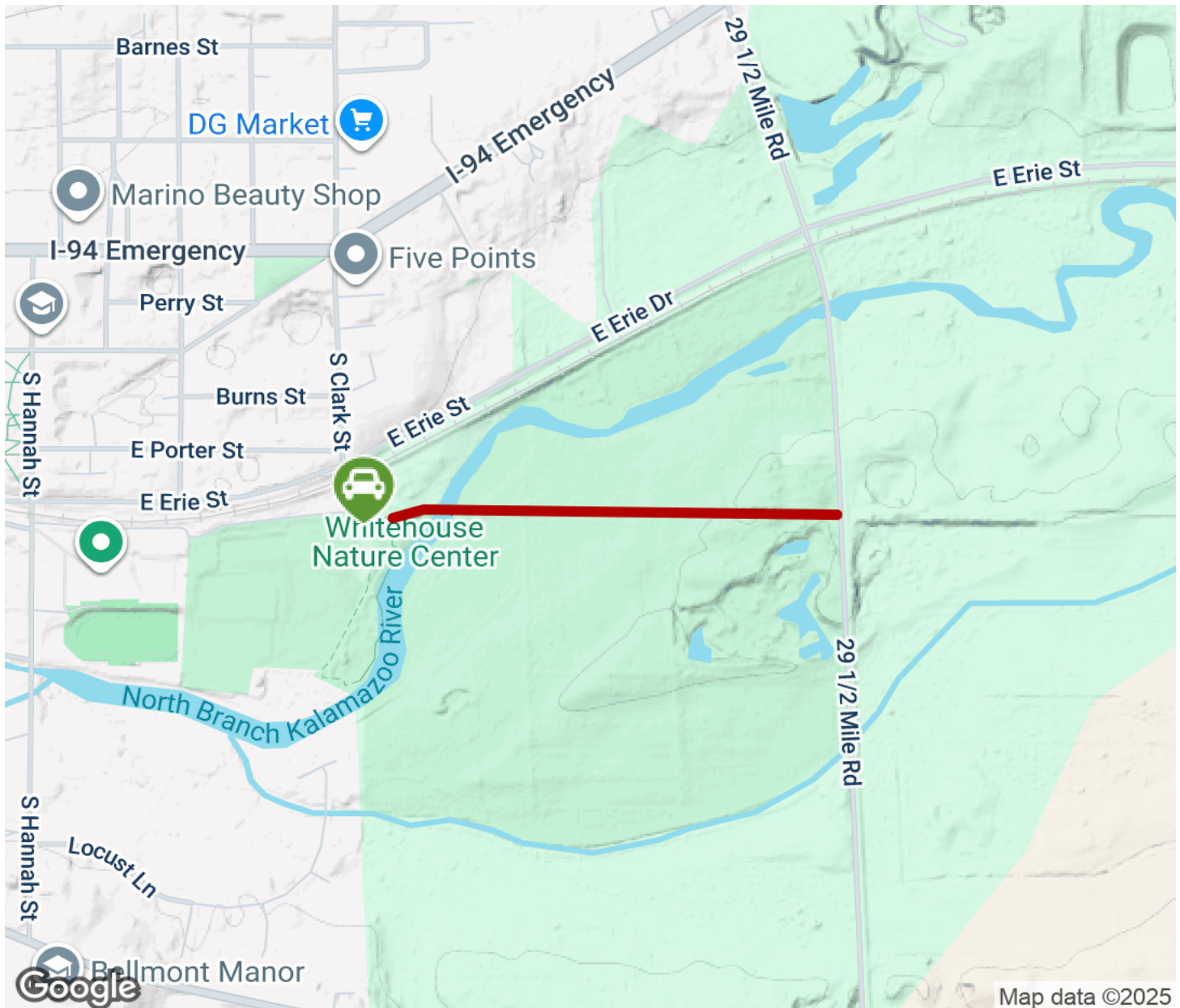
