Marquette Multi-Use Path

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Marquette's Multi-Use Path encompasses 19 miles of paved trail that circles the city from Presque Isle Park in the north to the town of Harvey in the south. The trail provides access to neighborhoods, shopping, business districts, city attractions, and recreation sites, including the popular Mattson Lower Harbor Park and [Iron Ore Heritage Trail](#).

The eastern leg of the trail follows the shore of Lake Superior, offering great views and beach access.


Parking & Trail Access
