The Lincoln Woods Trail runs for 2.6 miles along the east branch of the Pemigewasset River. You can combine the trail with [other trails](#) that run through the forest in the White Mountains of New Hampshire, just northeast of Lincoln, including the [Black Pond Trail](#) and the [Franconia Brook Trail](#). Together, the trails offer scenic mountain views, a beautiful waterfall and woodland adventure.

There's a visitor center at the trailhead at SR 112 (Kancamagus Highway).

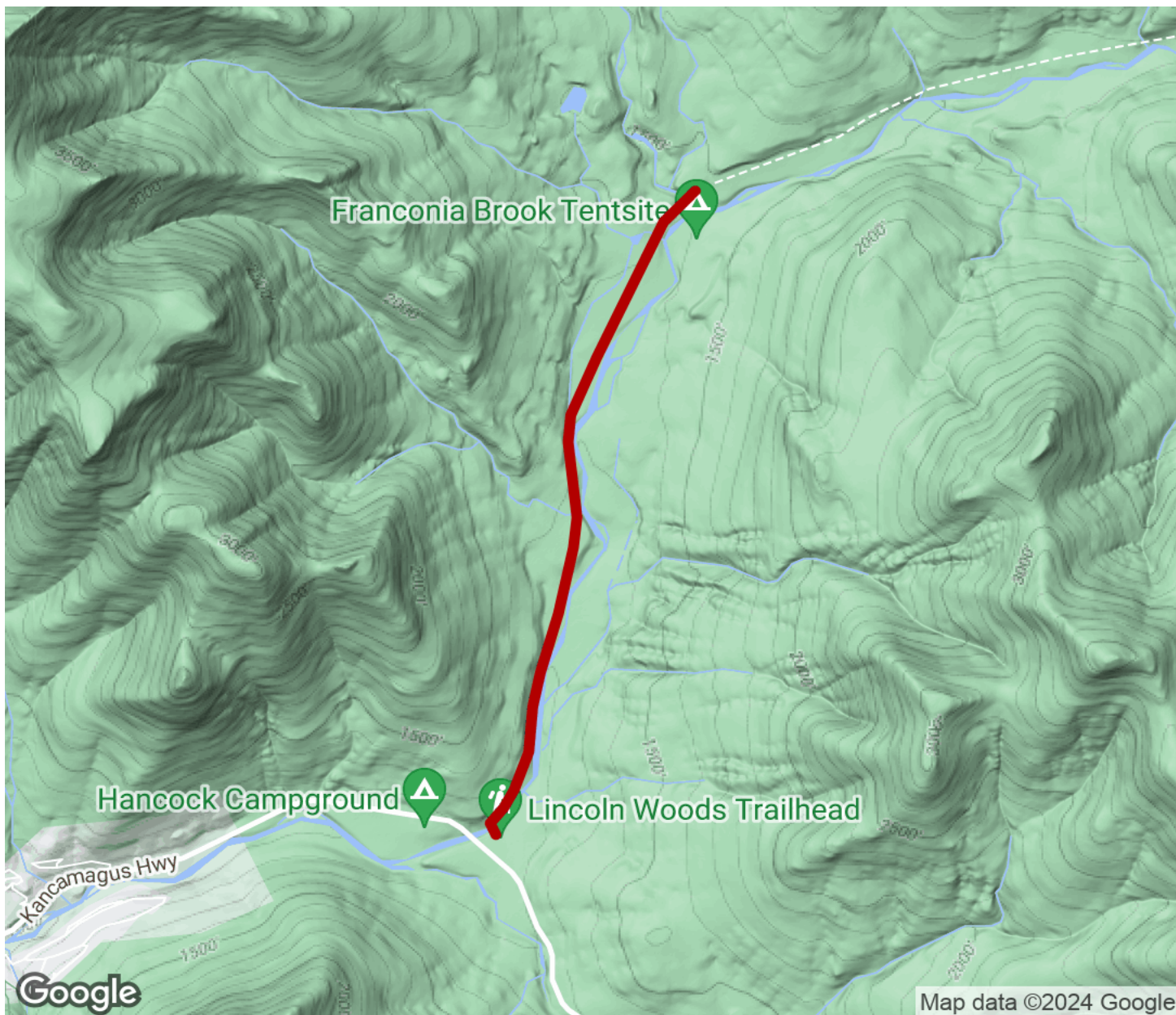
Parking & Trail Access
