MoPac Trail West

Nebraska



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MoPac Trail West follows the former Missouri Pacific Railroad's Omaha Belt Line (hence "MoPac") from central Lincoln to the city's eastern outskirts, where it joins the [MoPac Trail East](#). The concrete pathway begins on the University of Nebraska–Lincoln campus and connects students, faculty and other residents to local businesses, parks and shopping areas as it moves east. Future plans call for the MoPac Trail West and MoPac Trail East pair to be part of a 50-mile route connecting Lincoln and Omaha, Nebraska's two largest cities, by trail.

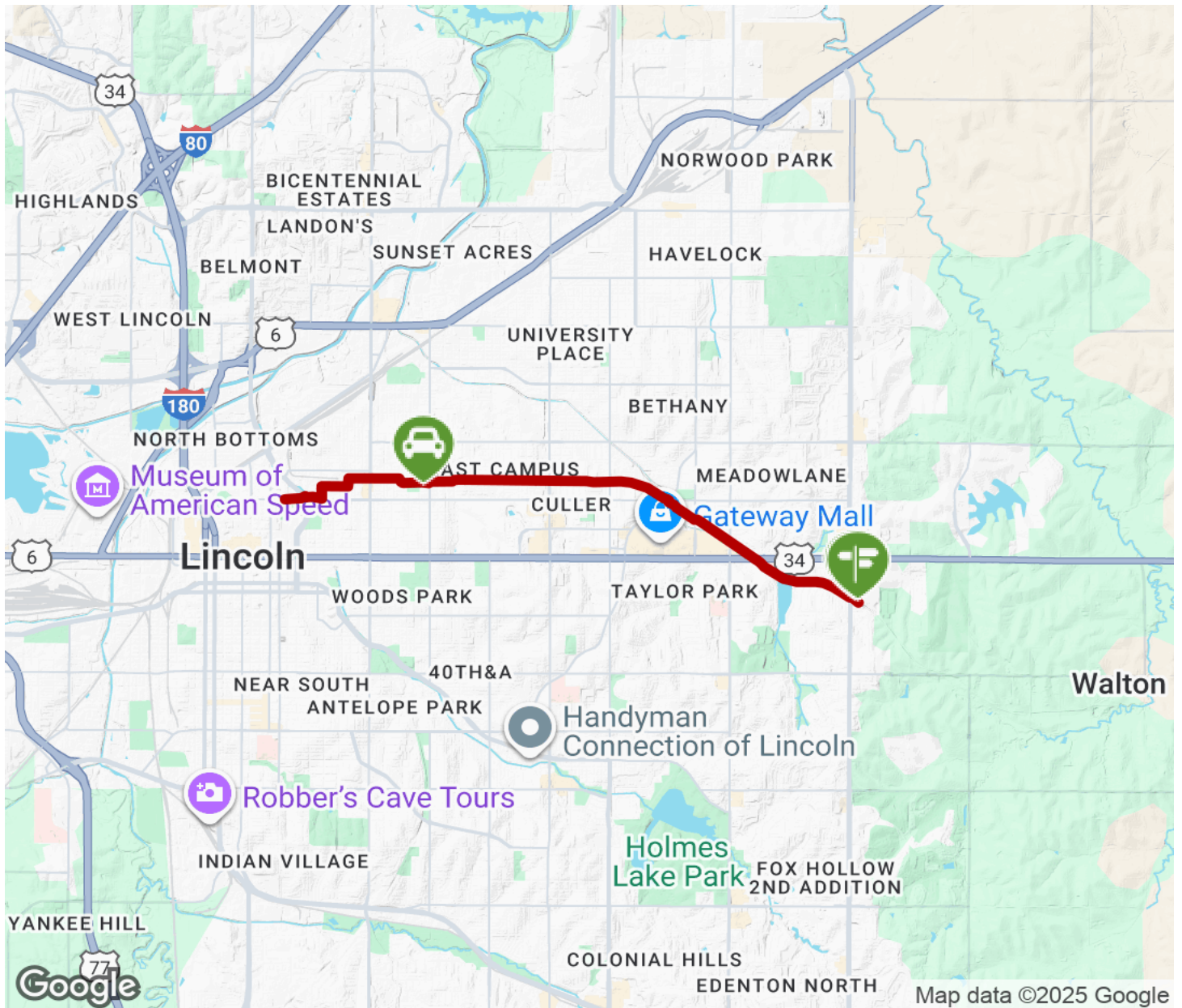
Parking & Trail Access
