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The Black Pond Trail itself is inaccessible by car, but when combined with the [Lincoln Woods Trail](#) which has available parking. Together, the trails offer scenic mountain views, a beautiful waterfall and woodland adventure.

Pick up the southern trailhead from the Lincoln Woods Trail and head north through dense forest to Black Pond.
