The Devil's Hole Trail offers a moderately challenging hike within Devil's Hole State Park. The rail trail follows the route of a former trolley line built in the Niagara Gorge in 1895. Railroad service ended in 1935 after a rockslide severely damaged the route.

About the Route

The wooded, unpaved pathway is just over a mile one way and includes a spectacular overlook of the Devil's Hole Rapids. Note that to access the trail, you will climb down a stone staircase into the gorge. Unlike most rail trails, the Devil's Hole Trail is not open to biking
