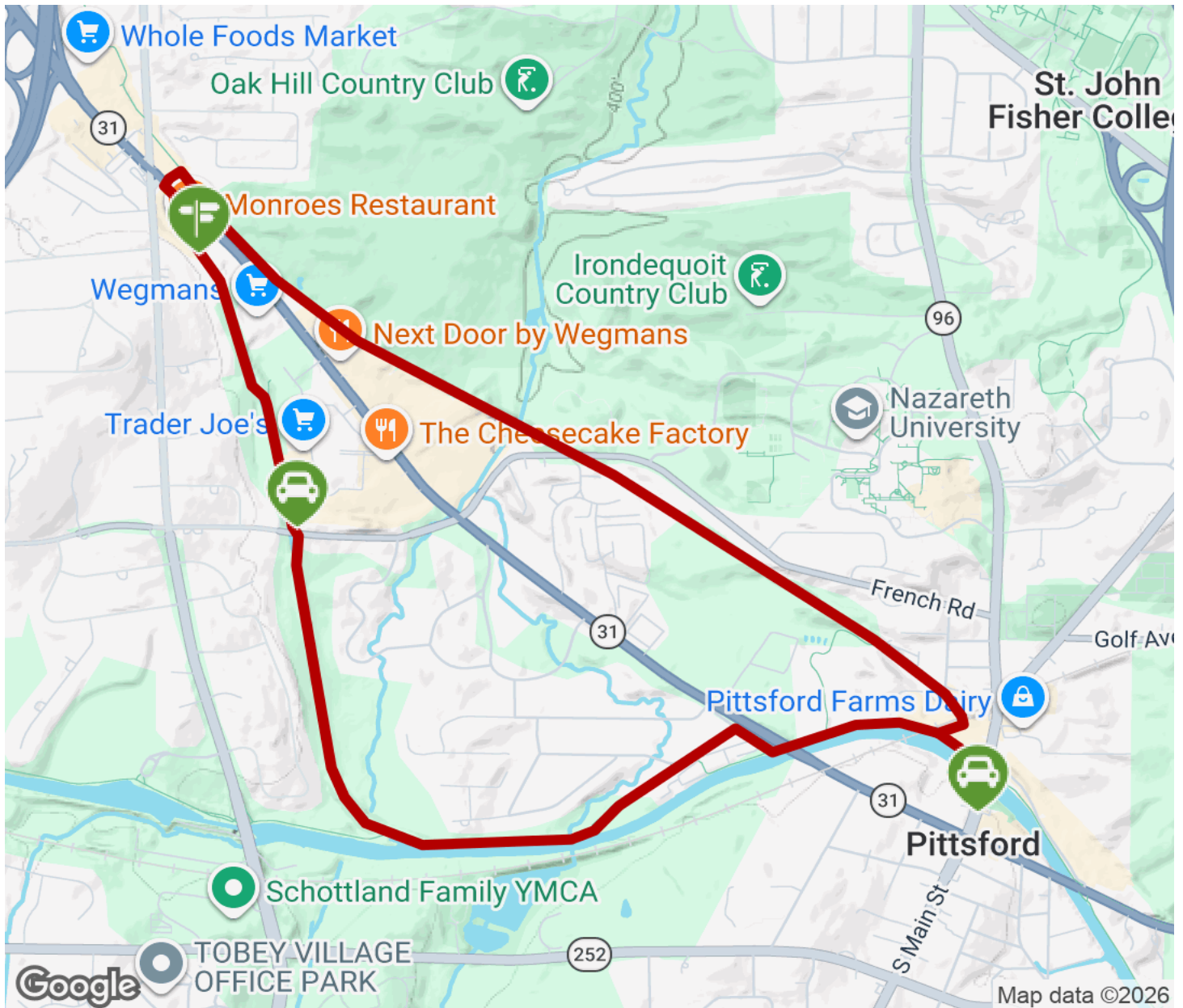
The Railroad Loop Trail runs in a circle around Pittsford.
