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Along the western section of the trail, the route passes the Sabina Farmers Exchange and the community of Reesville. Additionally, there is also a short on-road section in Sabina between Orchard Avenue and Howard Street.

The eastern section of trail similarly runs along the same flat, straight, and paved route.

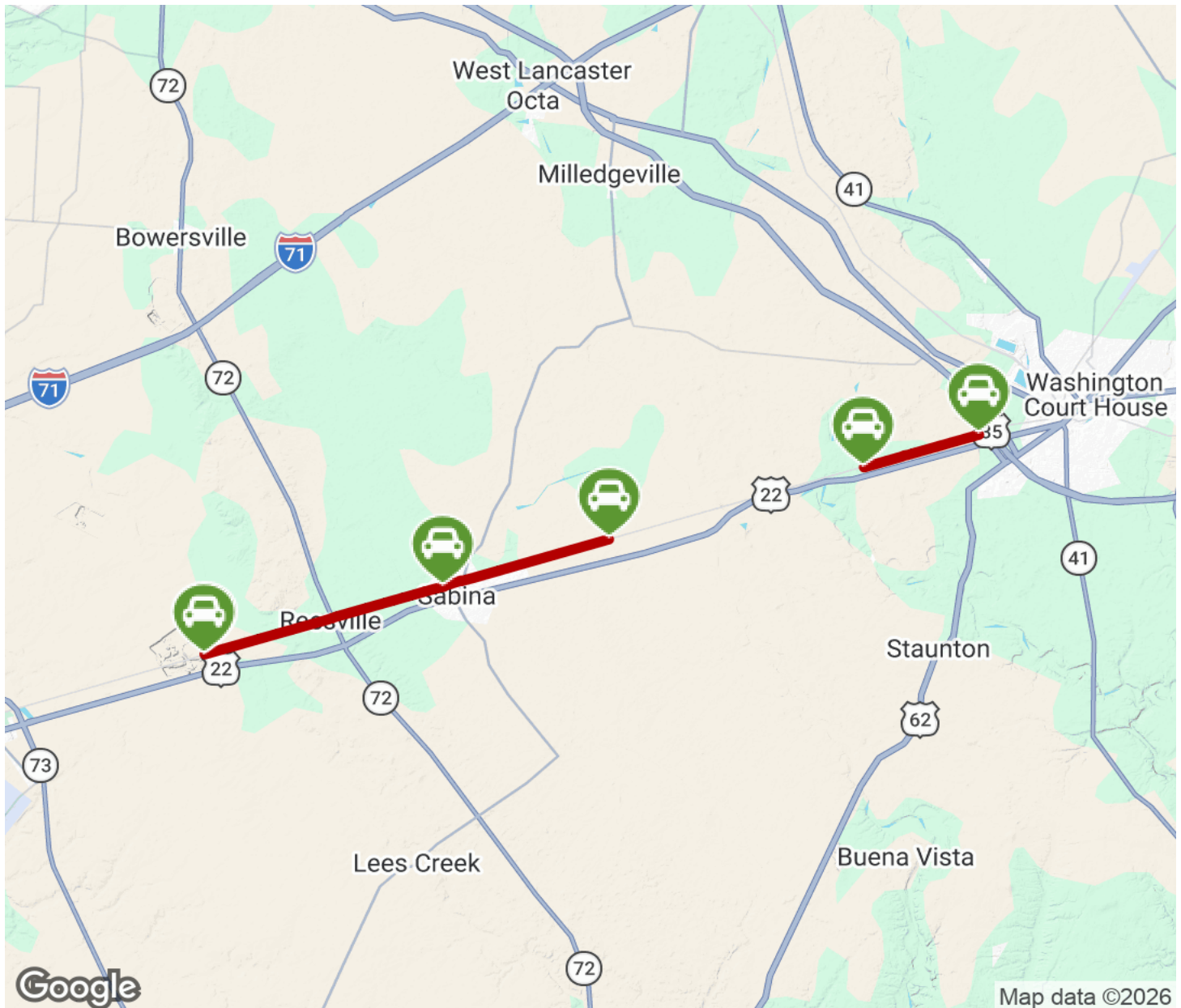
Parking & Trail Access
