Zane's Landing Trail

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The Zane's Landing Trail—also known as the Zanesville Riverfront Bike Path—extends north from downtown Zanesville on a former railroad corridor wedged between the Muskingum River and an active rail line. The southern terminus is in Zane's Landing Park, with the northern terminus in Riverside Park.

In downtown Zanesville, the paved trail lies near the docking port of the Lorena, a sternwheeler that navigates the Muskingum River, as well as a restored trail depot and the unique Y-Bridge just three blocks away.

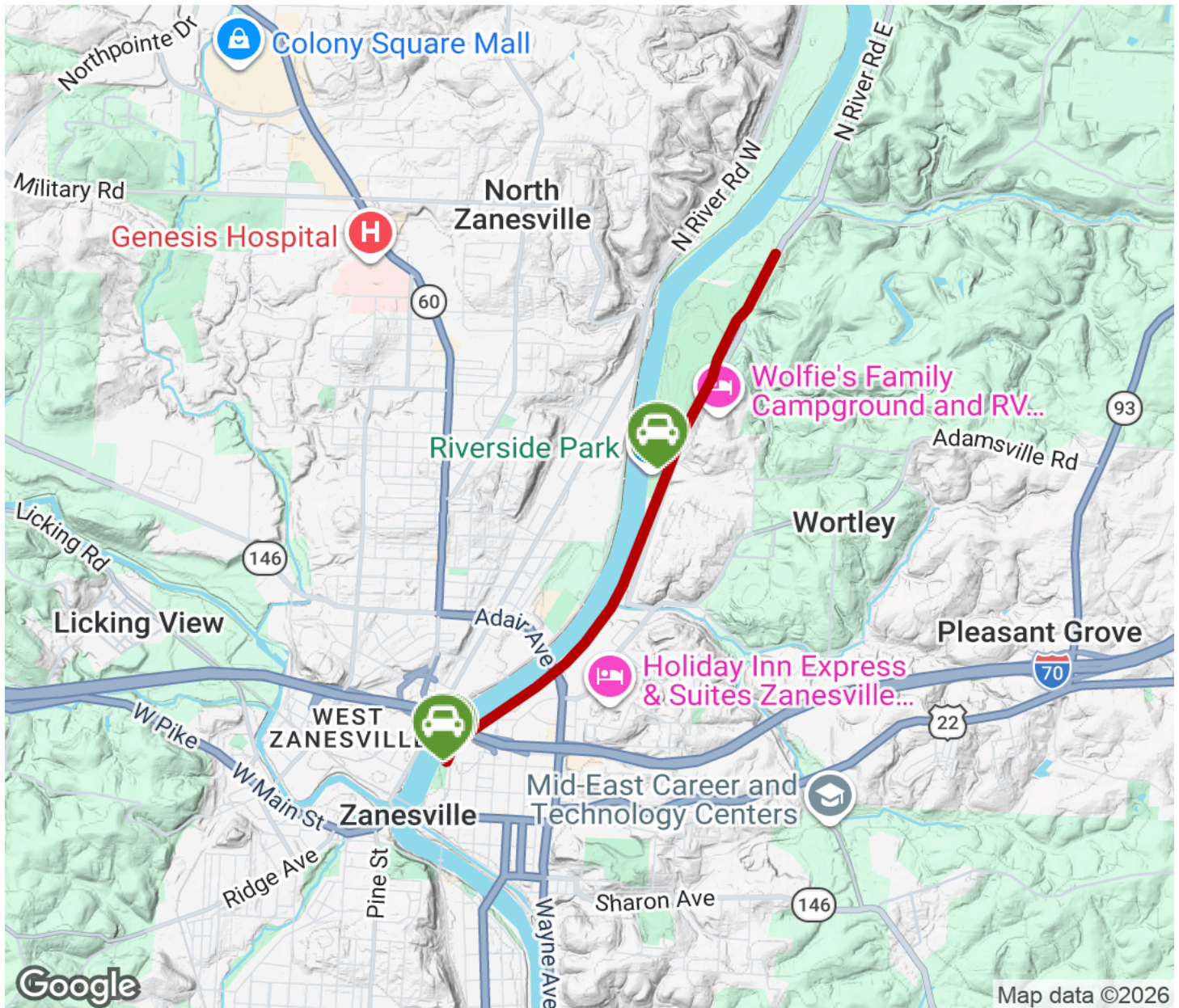
Parking & Trail Access
