The Central Ashland Bikepath is a paved trail that runs alongside the active Central Oregon and Pacific Railroad. It stretches from



The Central Ashland Bikepath is a paved trail that runs alongside the active Central Oregon and Pacific Railroad. It stretches from Tolman Creek Road to 6th Street, passing through Garfield Park and Railroad Park, which both offer picnic areas and restrooms. Hunter Park, which features 8 tennis courts and 2 baseball fields, is also along the trail.

The trail is a popular commuting route in Ashland, as it links residences with businesses and Southern Oregon University.

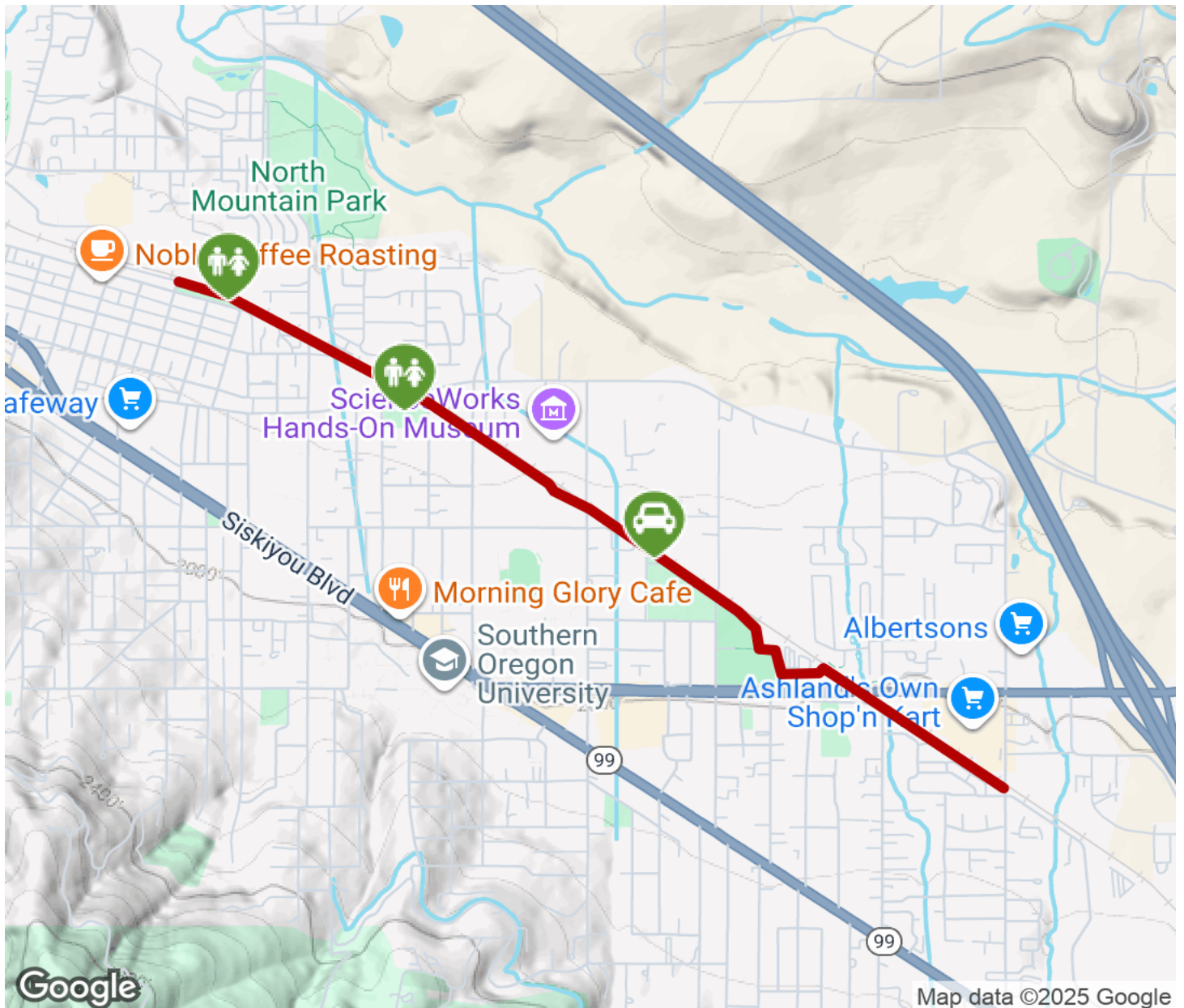
Parking & Trail Access
