About the Route

The western end of the Great Shamokin Path in Yatesboro is mostly grass but turns into dirt and gravel as the trail reaches its endpoint at Numine Ball Field. Most of the trail features a lovely tree canopy that provides relief on a hot summer's day. Wildlife can be seen along much of the trail, especially in the early mornings, but watch out for spiderwebs!

Parking & Trail Access


