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The Nebraska/Kelletville Trace Trail is primitive and unimproved. The trail crosses several streams that do not have bridges including the southernmost Coon Creek which trail users must cross to reach the southern parking. The trail follows the scenic Tionesta Creek with lots of great scenery and fishing.

This rail trail is not open for biking, but is instead an unimproved hiking route.

Parking & Trail Access

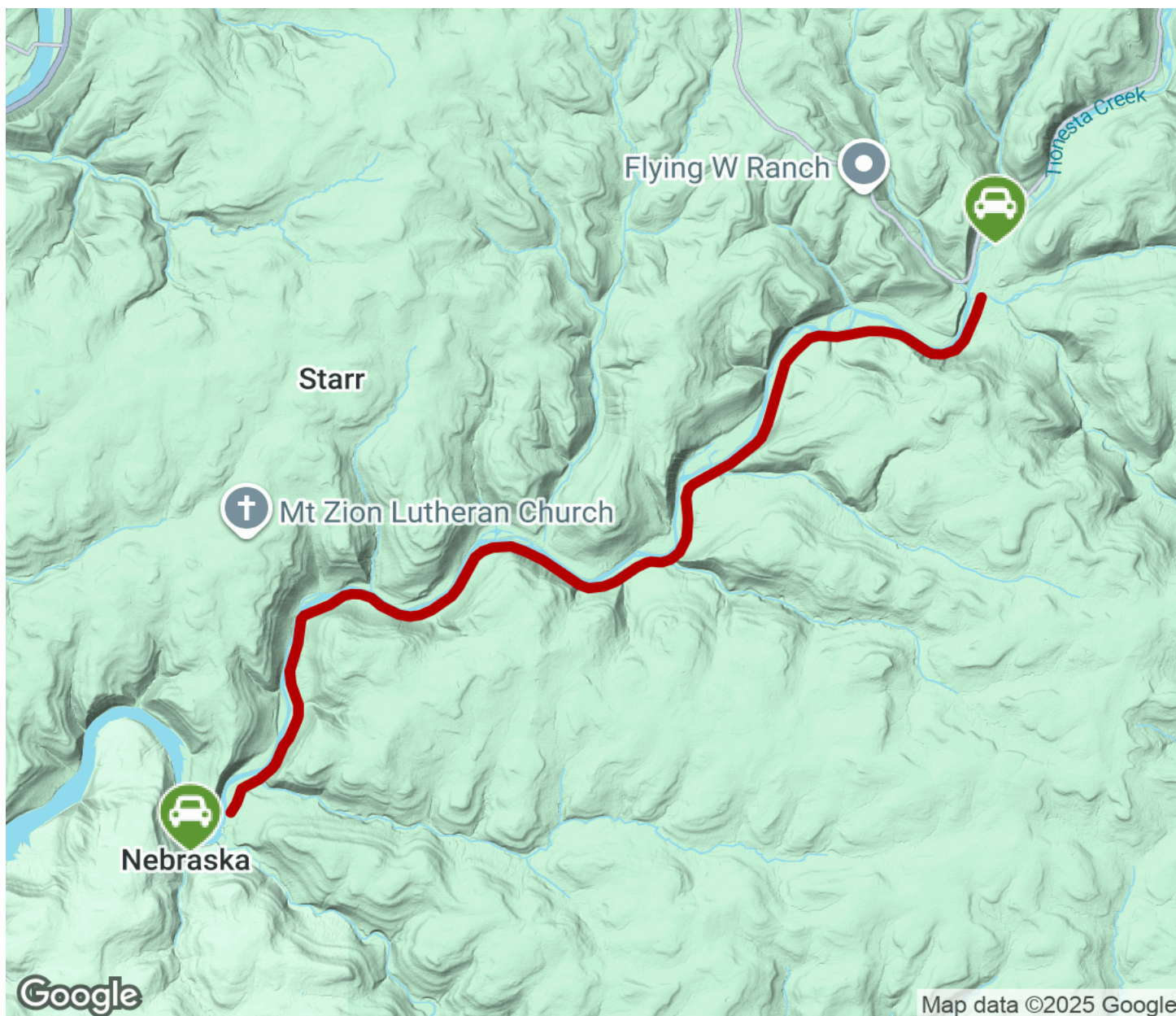
The Nebraska/Kelletville Trace Trail runs between the Kelletville and Nebraska bridges along Tionesta Creek.
