Part of the seven-mile network of trails in Little Buffalo State Park, two small sections of rail-trail form the Newport and Sherman's Valley Railroad Trace. Each rail-trail section is signed with directional arrows rather than named signs.

The western section of rail trail is part of the longer Little Buffalo Creek Trail, which can also be used for cross country skiing.

Parking & Trail Access

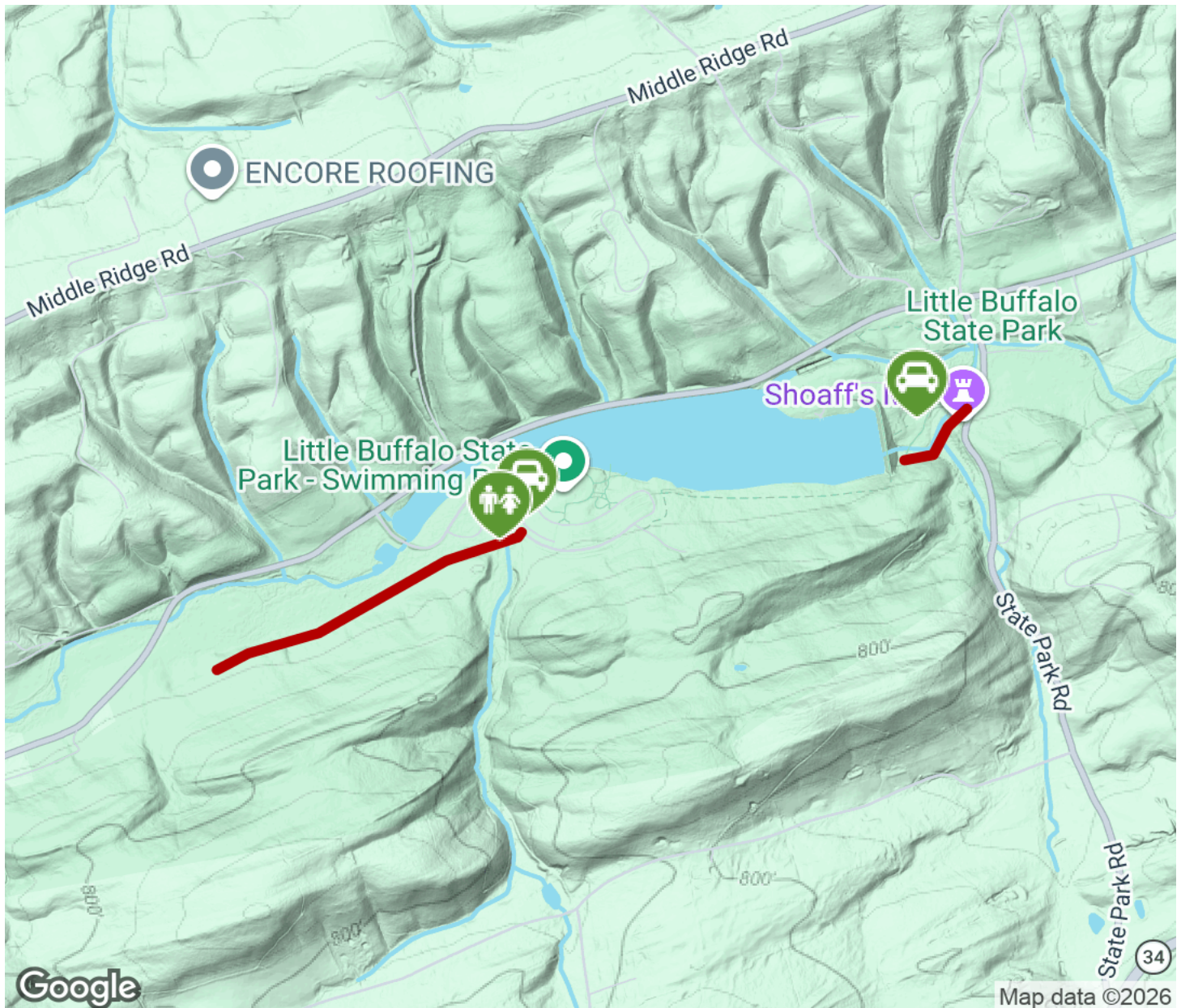
The Newport and Sherman's Valley Railroad Trace is accessible from several parking lots in Little Buffalo State Park.
