The Edisto Nature Trail loops through a forest maintained by WestRock (formerly Westvaco Corporation), a paper and



located nearby, for those looking for a wider variety of recreation options.

The Edisto Nature Trail loops through a forest maintained by WestRock (formerly Westvaco Corporation), a paper and packaging manufacturer. The main loop is 1 mile, and an inner loop adds 0.5 mile. Both sections of the trail wind through a typical low-country forest, which includes mature pines, hardwoods and bald cypress.

Grab a brochure at the trailhead for a self-guided tour and learn about the nearly 60 varieties of flora and fauna. A section of the trail winds through a cypress swamp atop an old railroad bed, which provides an excellent view of the forest. Other interesting landmarks include the historic King's Highway, an old railroad tram and an old phosphate operation.

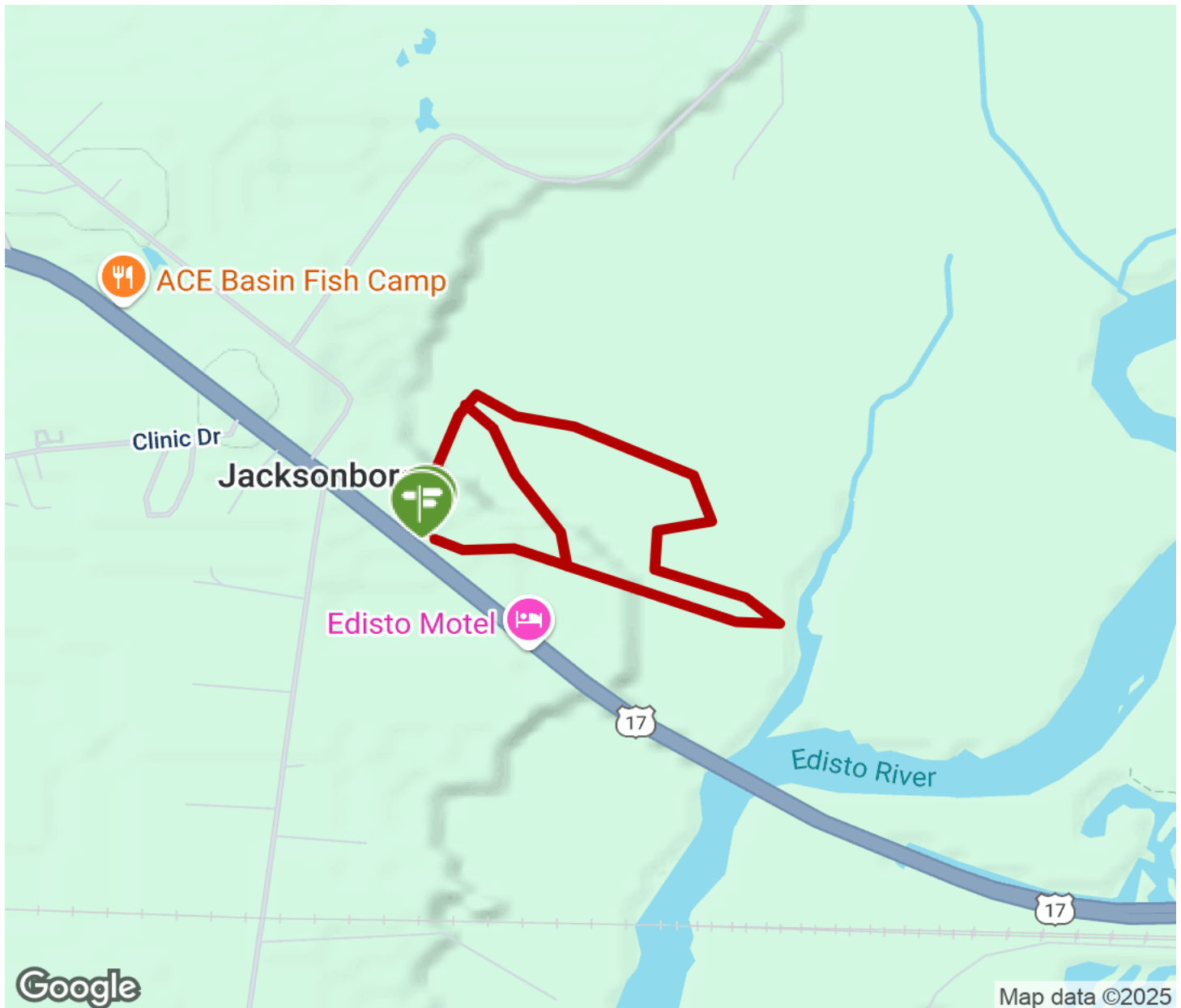
