The Holston River Greenway is one of many trails in Knoxville's greenway system. This 2-mile greenway is encompassed by Holston



The Holston River Greenway is one of many trails in Knoxville's greenway system. This 2-mile greenway is encompassed by Holston River Park and traverses through oak and beech forest, crossing an abandoned rail line and connecting to Riverside Dr.

The greenway makes a series of loops through Holston River Park. The park has fishing piers, a open green space, an exercise station accessible to people with disabilities, picnic shelters and two gazebos.


