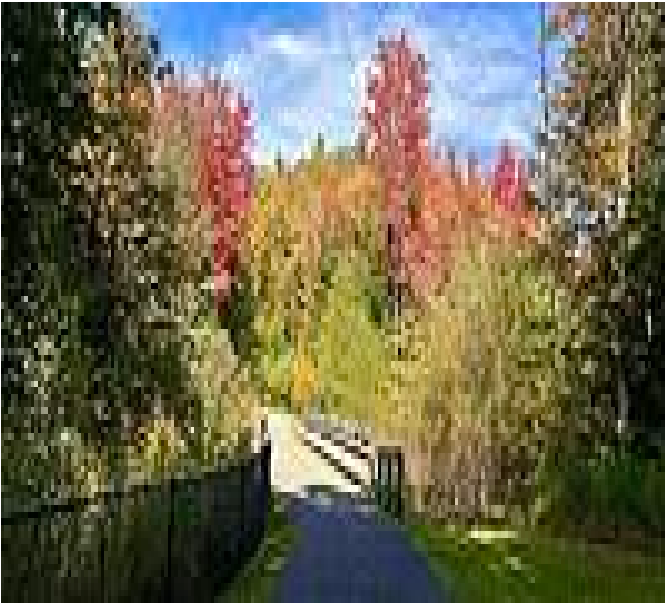

*The Millstone Hill West Bike Path connects the charming communities of Graniteville and Websterville in central Vermont.*



The Millstone Hill West Bike Path connects the charming communities of Graniteville and Websterville in central Vermont. The trail is part of the Central Vermont Path, a proposed trail network to connect Barre, East Barre, Westerville, Graniteville and Montpelier.

The paved 10-foot-wide pathway begins at Barre Town Middle and Elementary School and travels south for about 2 miles through mostly wooded areas. It ends near the Rock of Ages Center, a popular attraction featuring a 600-foot-deep granite quarry as well as a factory where visitors can watch sculptors and artisans carve the stone. Near the center, you'll also cross a 54-foot historic bridge.

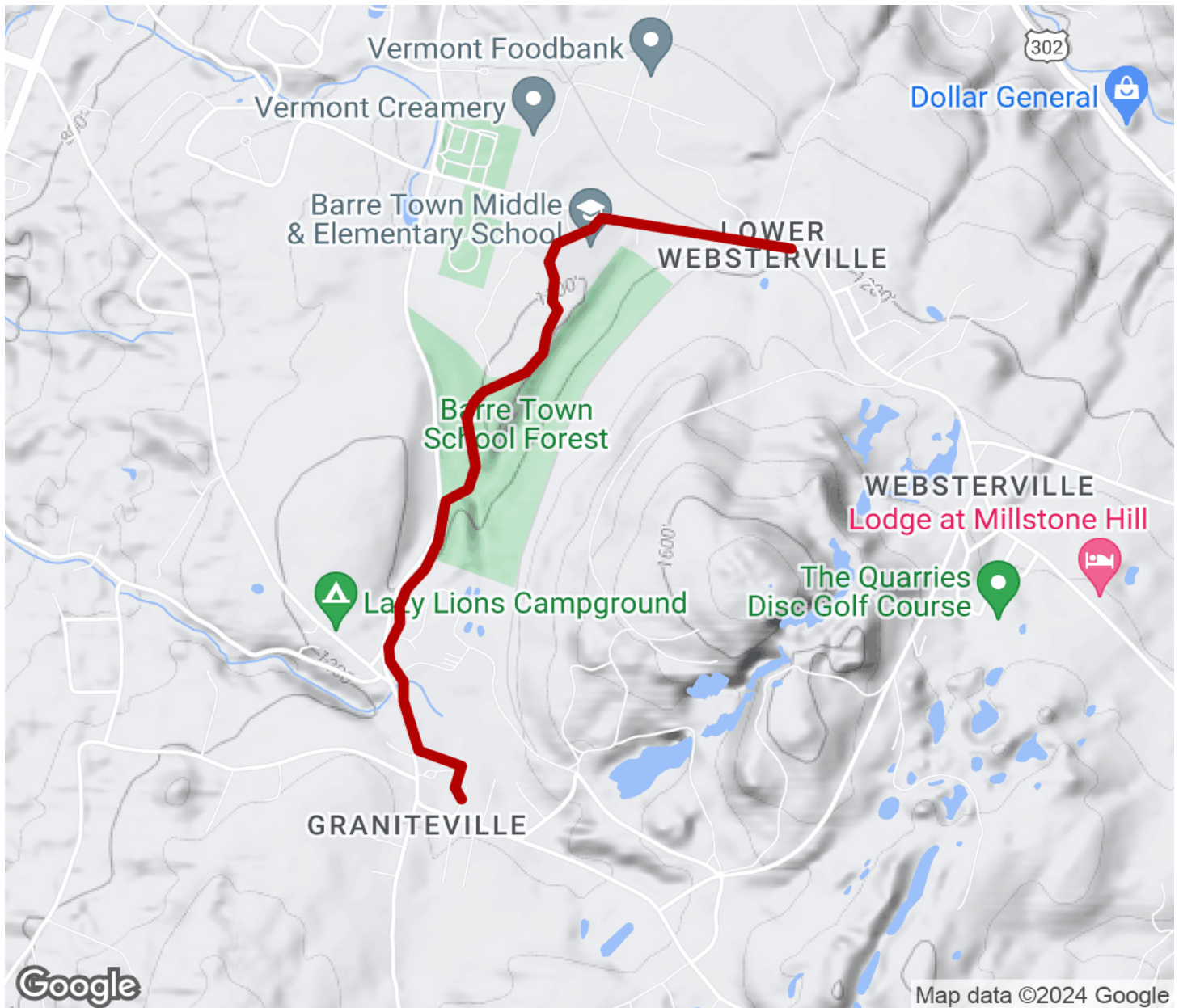
## Parking & Trail Access
