The trail is well-shaded, and a large open space dotted with mature trees at its eastern end is a popular spot to read, rest or picnic.

The trail also provides a safe route to school for students of Indian Creek Elementary, located conveniently at the trail's western end.

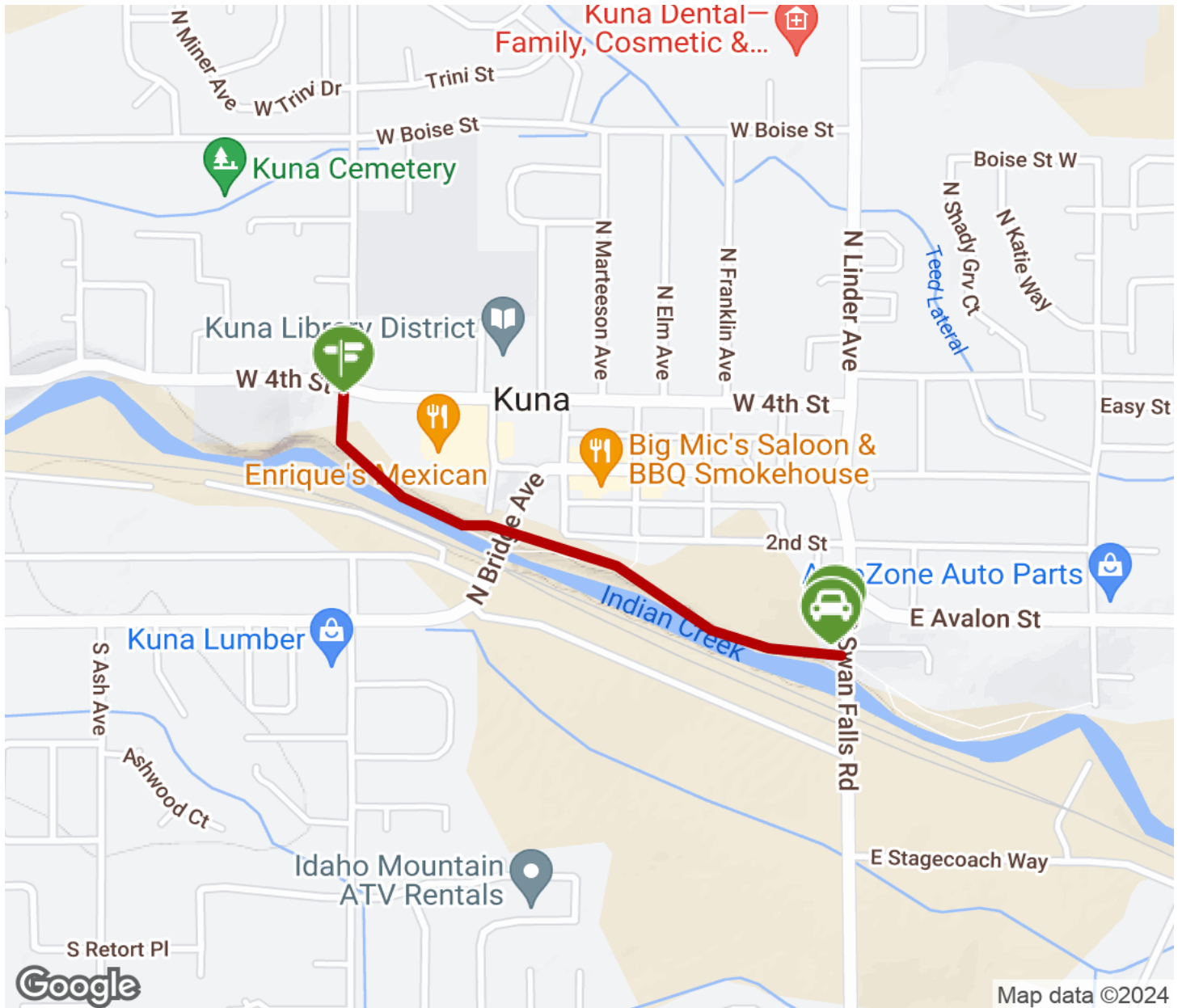
## Parking & Trail Access
