Duwamish Trail

Washington



Running north to south along the industrial Duwamish Waterway, the 3-mile Duwamish Trail is an important connector in southwest



Running north to south along the industrial Duwamish Waterway, the 3-mile Duwamish Trail is an important connector in southwest Seattle. Beginning a half mile south of the Alki Trail, the Duwamish Trail parallels W. Marginal Way for much of its route. Approaching its southern end, it heads under Highway 509, where it splits, ending in the Georgetown neighborhood to the north and the South Park neighborhood to the south.
