Overview

The Parksville Rail Trail is the northernmost section of the Sullivan O&W Trail, which runs for 20.65 miles in Sullivan County in 7 distinct sections along the previous O&W Railroad Main Line and Port Jervis Branch.

About the Route

The northernmost section of the Sullivan O&W Rail Trail runs for 1.33 miles between Rte. 17 and the hamlet of Parksville.

The route is entirely unpaved. At the trailhead located in the Parksville business district, there is informational signage.
