The Wood Duck Nature Trail, appropriately named for the secretive duck, was made possible through the hard work and dedication of refuge volunteers. This beautiful trail extends about 1.5 miles on a former railroad bed ending at the Wallkill River. There is only access available at the northern end of the trail so trail users must travel out-and-back.

The self-guiding interpretive trail includes a nature photography blind, interpretive nature signs, a footbridge across Beaver Run and several benches. Extensive wetlands are located along the trail. The trail is flat and provides easy walking.

Bicycles, horses and motorized vehicles are not permitted on the trail.

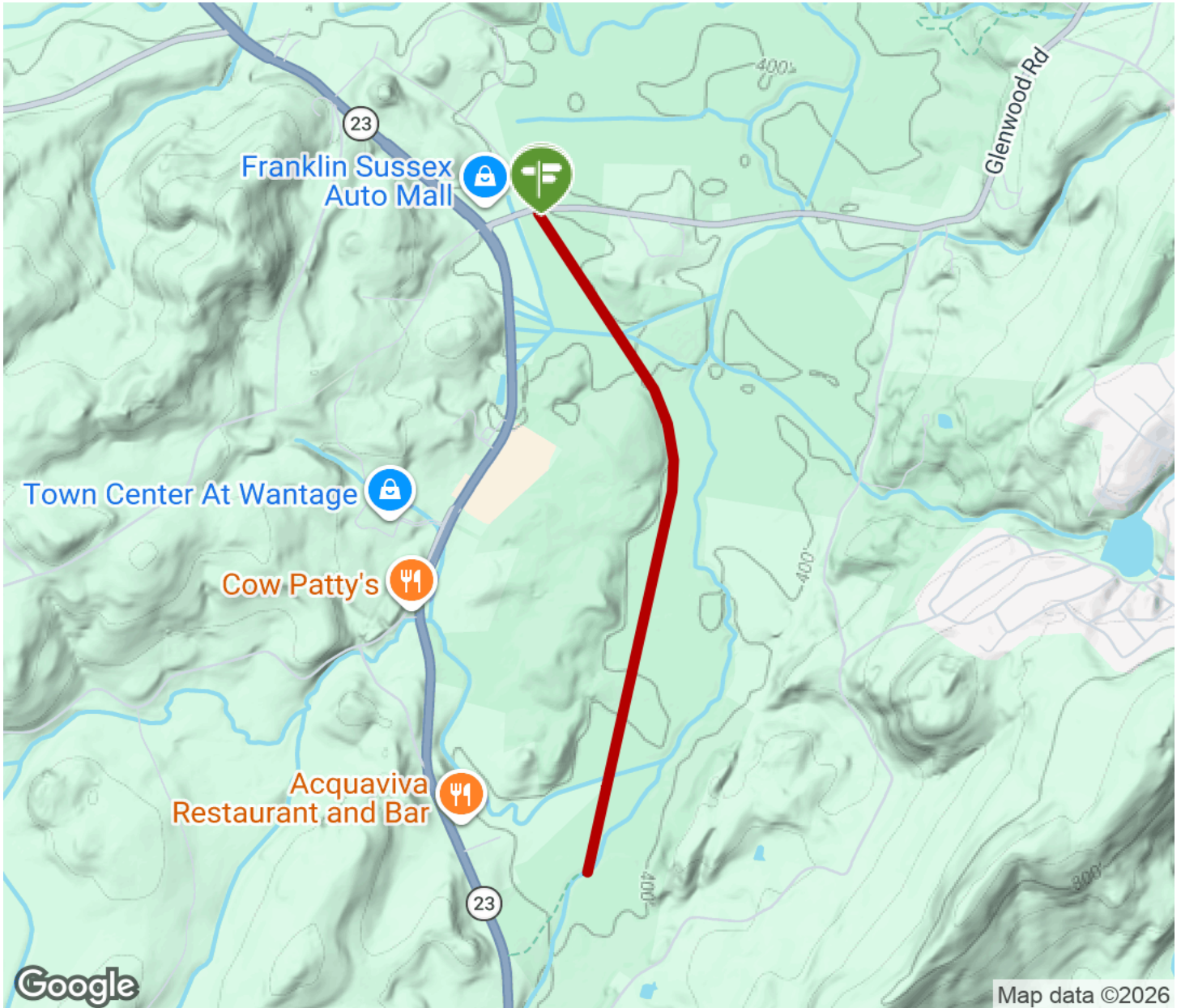
The Wood Duck Nature Trail is an out-and-back trail with trailhead and access available at 295 NJ-23.
