Olympic Parkway Trail

Utah

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The Olympic Parkway Trail stretches from Olympic Flag Park in Park City north to Snyderville. It follows Snow Creek Drive for a short distance before crossing it and parallels State Route 224/Park Avenue, a.k.a. Olympic Parkway, to Snyderville. The trail offers spectacular mountain and valley views. Several other trails in the area offer mountain biking and hiking.

Parking & Trail Access

To access the trail, take Exit 145 off I-80 onto SR 224 to Park City and park in town. There is another access point about midway along the trail toward Snyderville. Carry on SR 224 from Park City for 4 miles; the Farm trailhead is on the right.



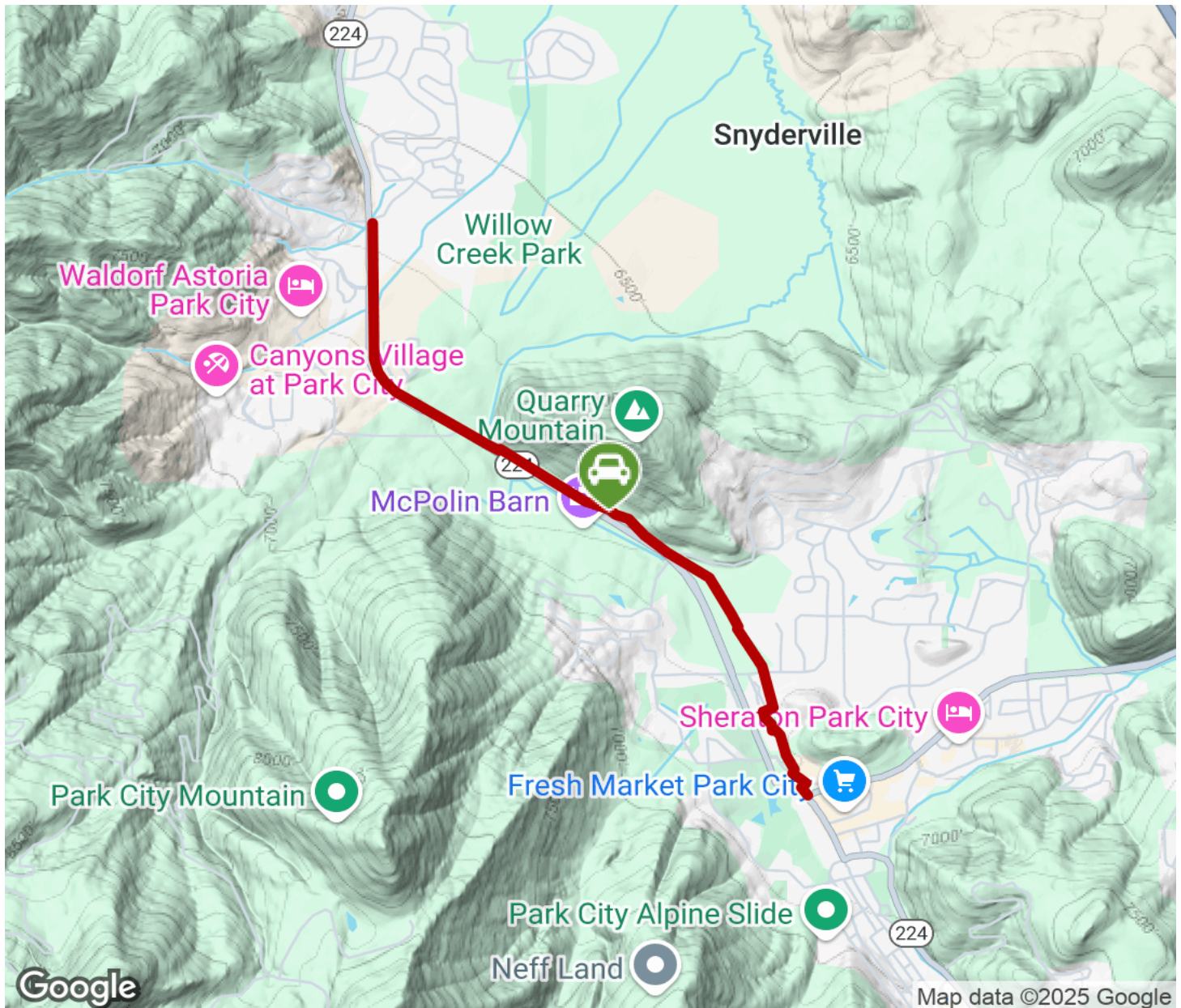
