The Interlink Trail connects the southern end of Wisconsin's portion of the 47-mile <u>Gandy Dancer Trail</u> with Interstate Park in St. Croix Falls. Along the way, the Polk County Information Center offers restrooms, parking and resources for visitors to the area.

In the west, Interstate Park—Wisconsin's oldest state park—offers stunning views of the St. Croix River (and Minnesota on the opposite shore), which courses through a gorge carved by glaciers. An interpretive center at the park features exhibits on this fascinating glacial history. The Interlink Trail also connects to an extensive network of hiking trails that weave through the park.


Parking & Trail Access
