## Lake Country Trail

Wisconsin

*The 15.2-mile Lake Country Trail runs from the western edge of Waukesha to Oconomowoc in Wisconsin's Lake Country area. Most*



Memorial Golf Course are located along the Lake Country trail just to the east of Delafield. Visit the park to enjoy swimming, boating, and fishing in Nagawicka or Pewaukee lakes.

The 15.2-mile Lake Country Trail runs from the western edge of Waukesha to Oconomowoc in Wisconsin's Lake Country area. Most of the trail was built on a former Milwaukee-Watertown Interurban Railway right-of-way, now shared with Wisconsin Electric Power Company overhead electric lines.

### About the Route

The view from the rail trail is primarily farmland and rolling hills, although adjacent roadways are rarely out of sight. Occasionally, you can catch glimpses of Pewaukee Lake and Upper Nemahbin Lake from the tops of some of the taller hills.

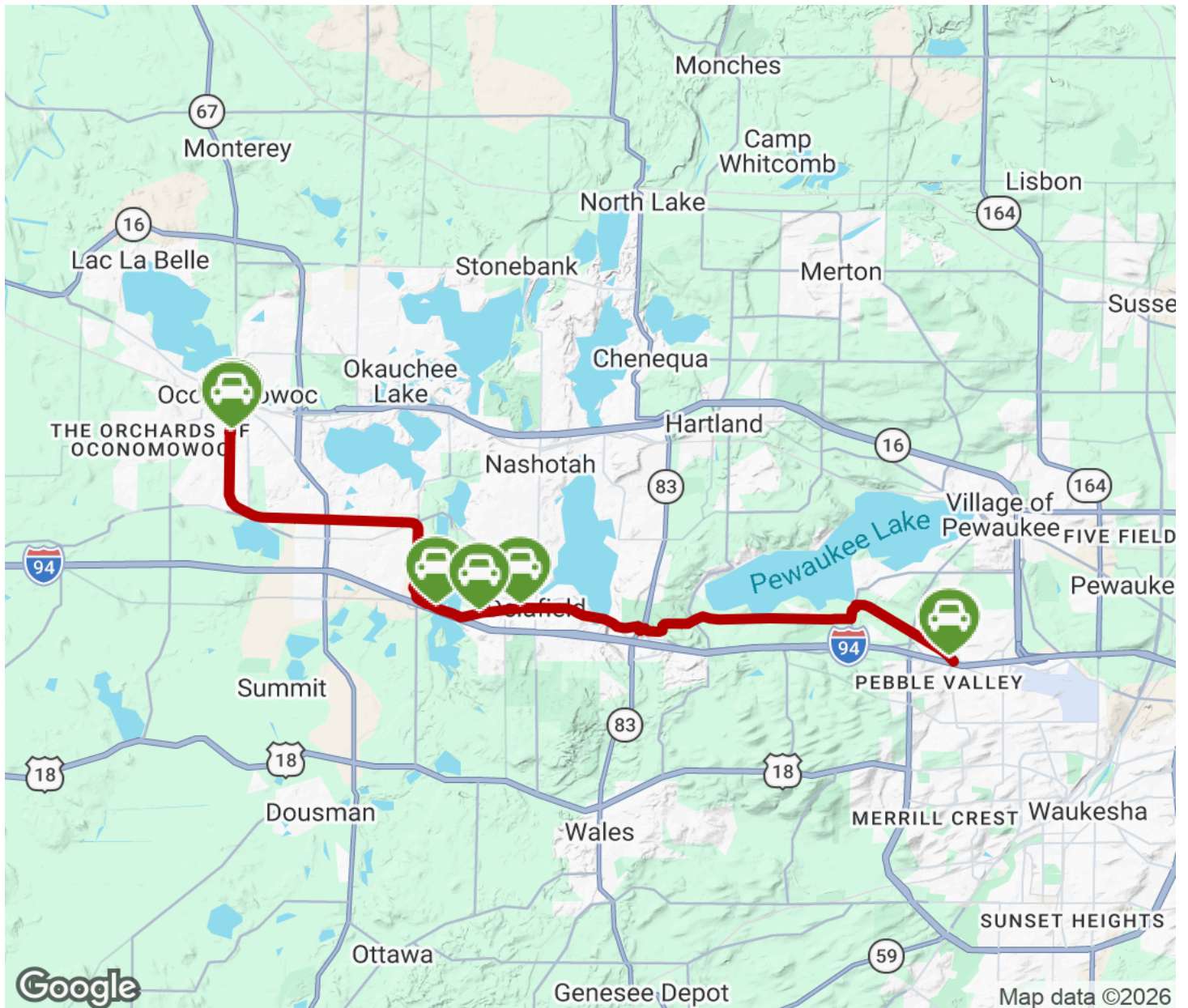
