Access the trail from County Road W (Irondale Road) south of Oliver.



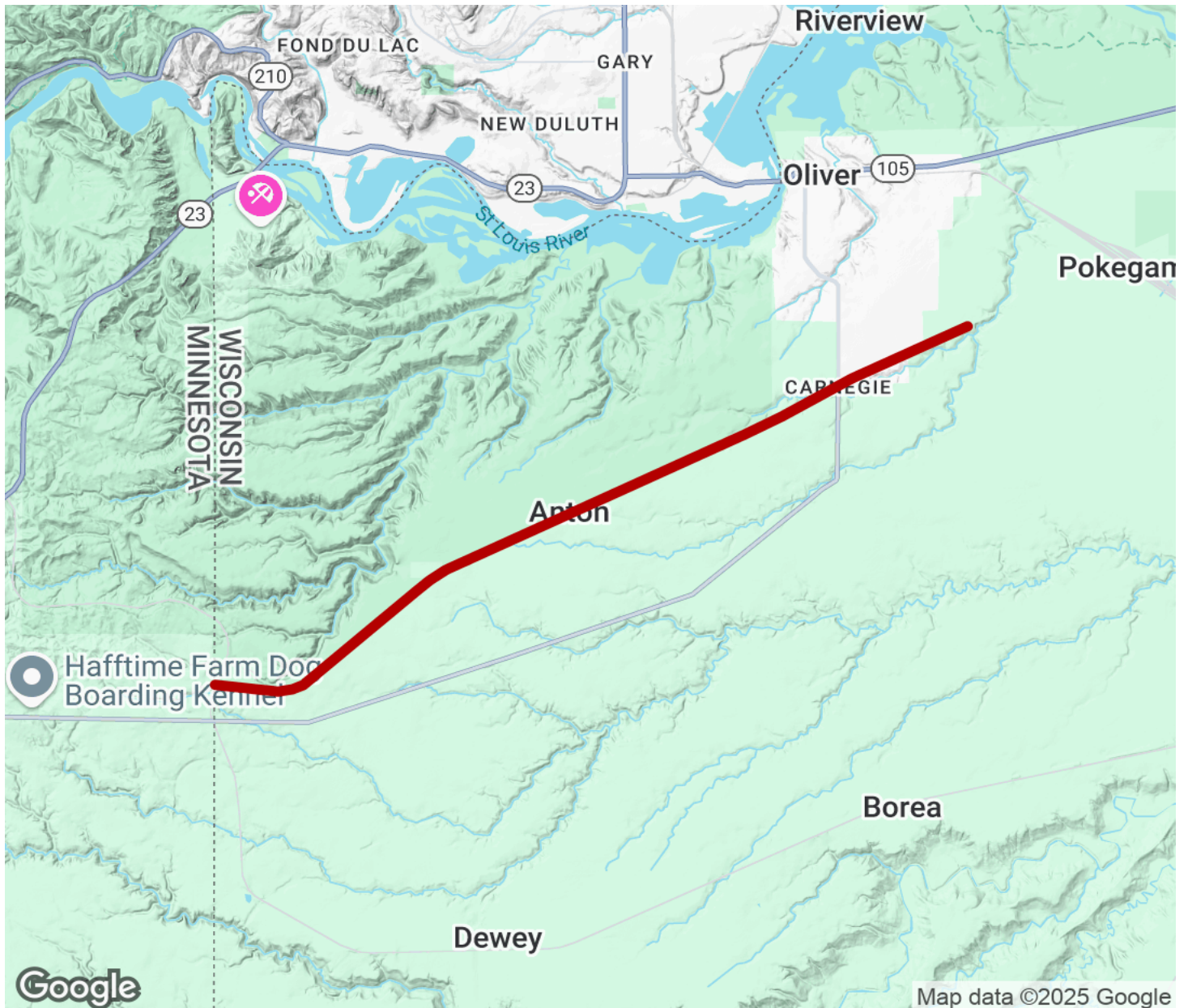
