Parking and trail access is off Old Dock Road at the basball diamonds on the west end.



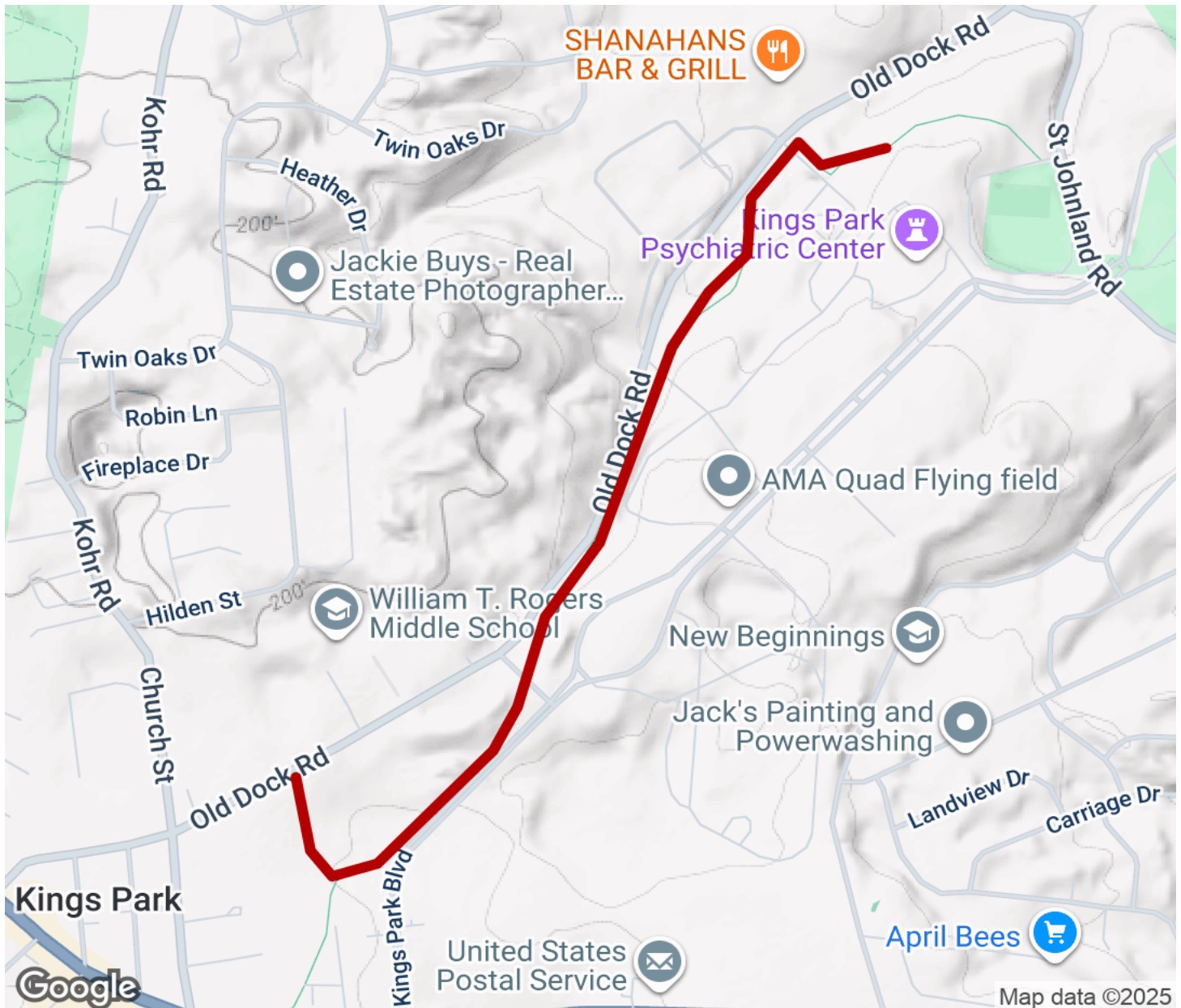
