Saunders State Trail

Wisconsin

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The 8.4-mile Saunders State Trail links with the [Gandy Dancer Trail](#) at Borea, southwest of Superior, and continues into Minnesota, where it is known as the [Soo Line Trail](#) (southern route). The trail is popular with snowmobilers, equestrians, ATVers, mountain bikers, hikers, and cross-country skiers. Its surface is a rough ballast. During summer, trail users can find wild raspberries and a variety of flowers growing along the trail.

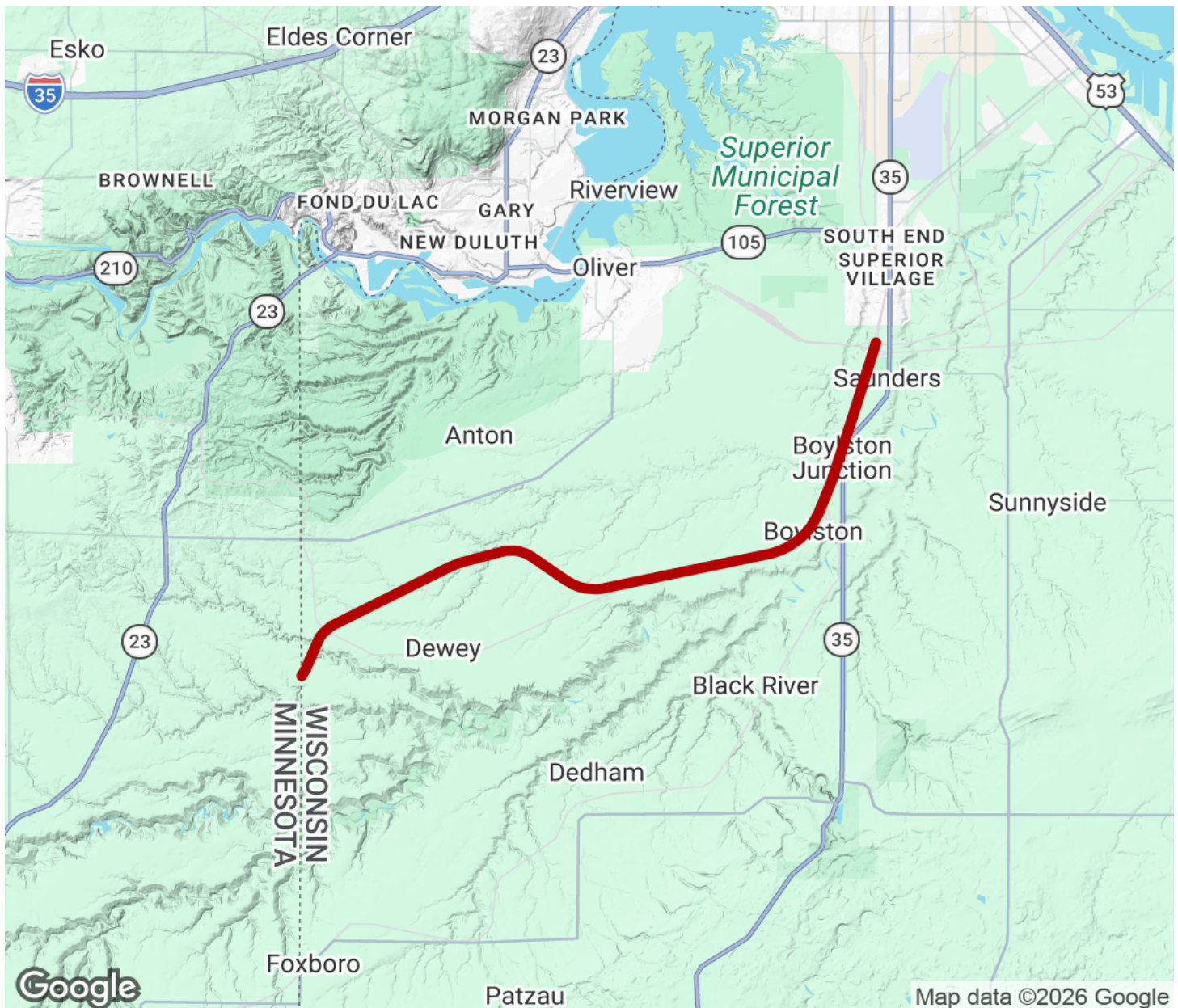
