Old Railroad Bridge Trail

Alabama



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The Old Railroad Bridge Trail in northwestern Alabama offers a short connection between Sheffield on the south side of the Tennessee River and Florence on the river's north bank. The paved trail travels through a pleasantly wooded area and offers spectacular views as it crosses the river on the Old Railroad Bridge, spanning more than 1,500 feet.

Although the trail has a linear north-south course, it is considered a loop because there is no outlet at its northern end, so travelers have to turn around and head back the way they came at trail's end.

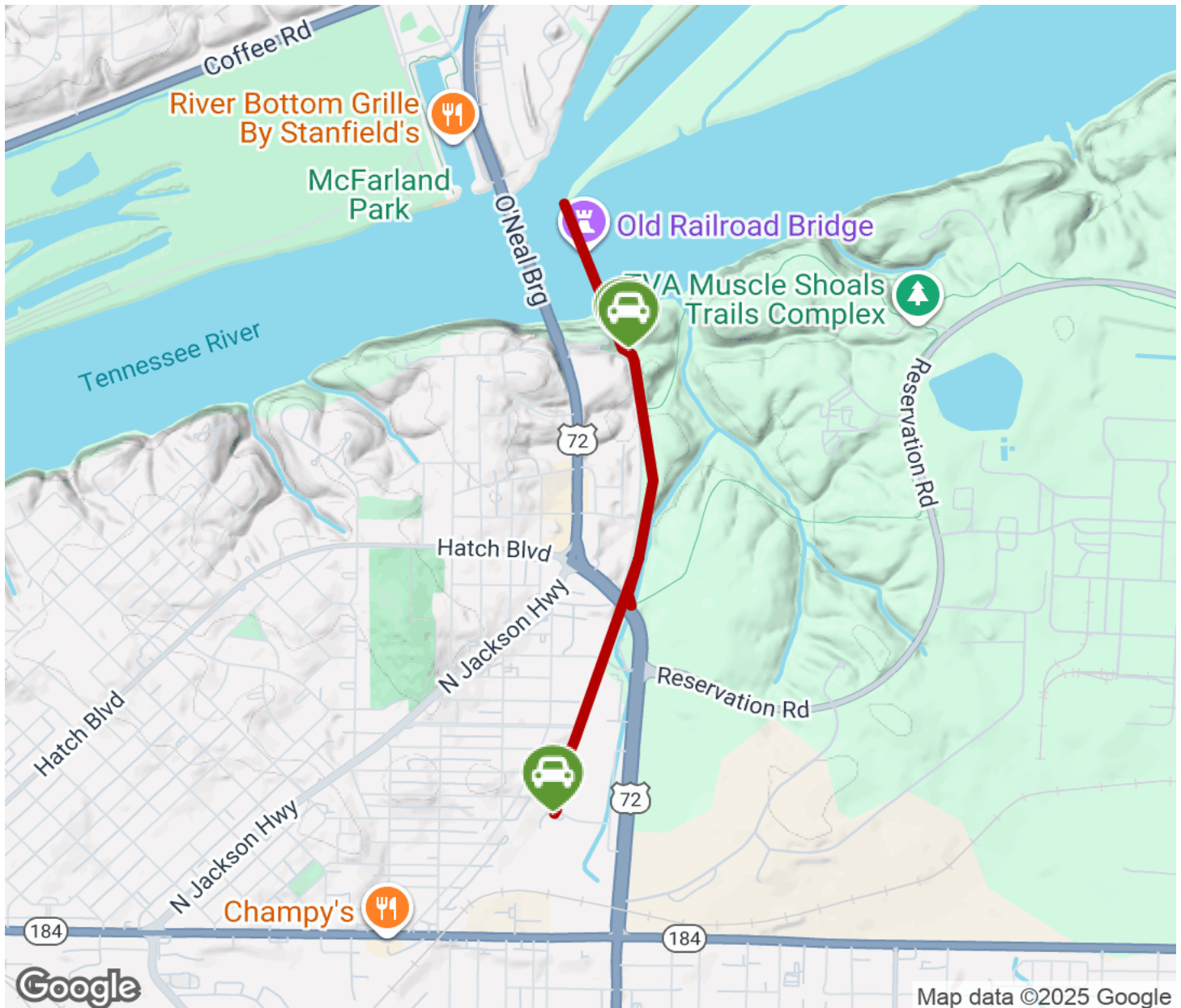
Parking & Trail Access
