At its heart is Bol Park, a strip of playground and lawn laid alongside Matadero Creek. The area was once home to a donkey pasture, and two donkeys remain to greet visitors from a private corral just off the trail.

The trail is also popular with students who use the path to reach Gunn High School at the trail's southern end on weekdays.

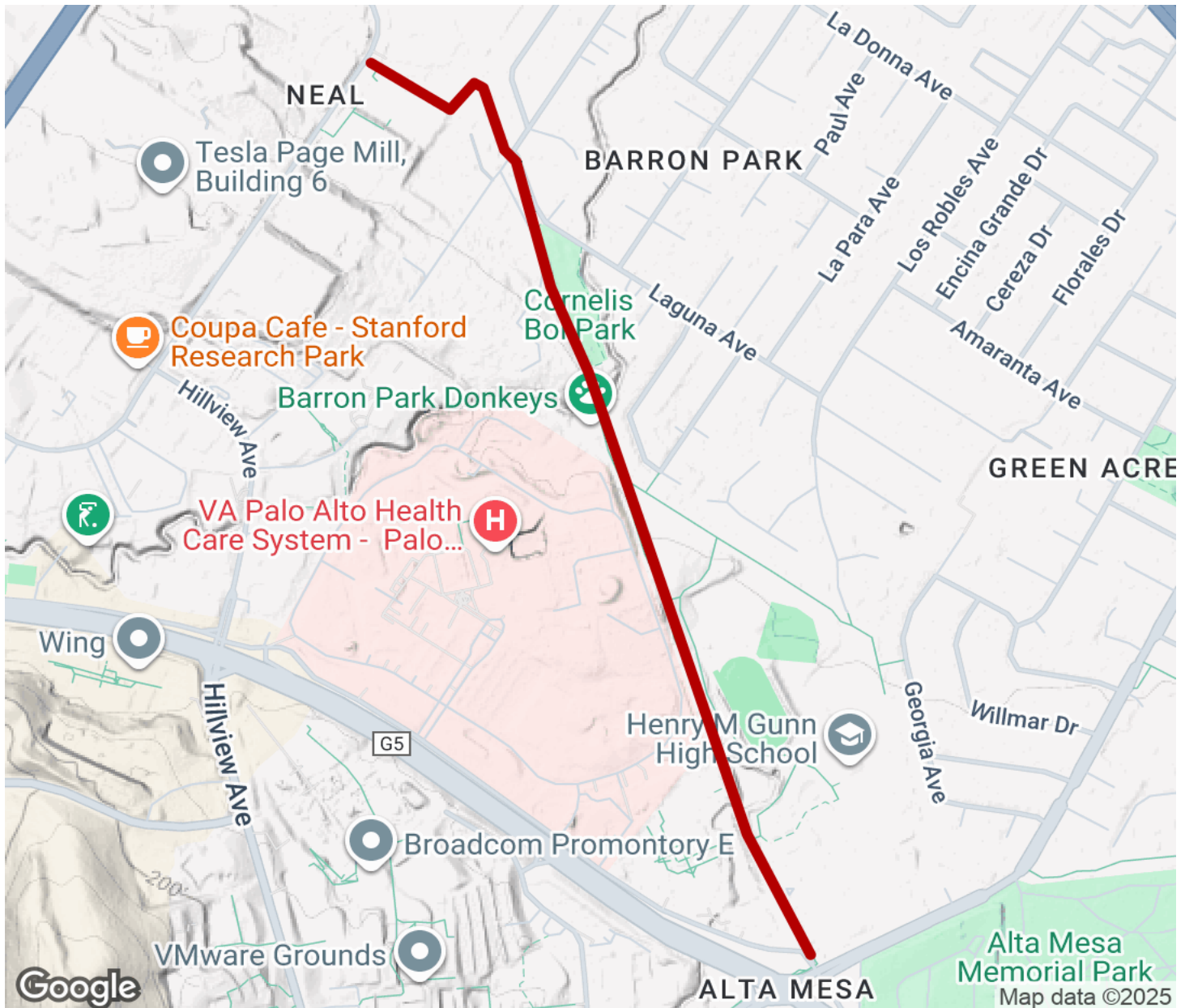
Parking & Trail Access
