Middle Fork Snoqualmie River Trail

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The Middle Fork Snoqualmie River Trail is open to hikers and horseback riders. The trail can be difficult to navigate in places, since other trails link with it (some unmaintained). There are a few stream and forest road crossings. 
Parking & Trail Access

From Seattle take I-90 East to Exit 34 and turn left at the stop sign. In just over a mile, turn right on Forest Road 56 (SE Middle Fork Road). Continue for 11.6 miles to the trailhead on the right.
