The Paseo del Bosque Trail is a 16-mile urban greenway in Albuquerque.

About the Route

Following the Rio Grande for about 16 miles, the trail passes by the Rio Grande Conservation Center and the Albuquerque BioPark and Zoo. The only cars are on the occasional bridges that pass over the trail. The route is fairly flat the whole way except when passing under the bridges. Originally set aside as part of open land initiative, the Paseo del Bosque Trail is a highlight of Albuquerque.
