White Rock Lake Park Loop Trail Texas



The White Rock Lake Park Loop Trail runs in a loop around White Rock Lake, and is one of the most popular trails in the city of Dallas.



At the northern end of the loop, trail users can continue along the White Rock Lake Park Trail.

Near the White Rock Boathouse and the fish hatchery, the trail connects to the <u>SoPac Trail</u>.

About the Route

Along the trail's loop, trail users have access to numerous amenities. At the northern end of the trail, people will find the White Rock Lake Dog Park, Boy Scout Hill Pavillion, and White Rock Boat Club. Along the eastern shore of the lake, the trail passes the Dallas Arboretum and Botanical Gardens. Along the western shore, the trail passes another boathouse, as well as Lakewood Park.
